Mount Helena is a City Park. It has multiple hiking trails to the top of the Mountain. The trail head starts at Reeders Alley in downtown Helena. The paths are groomed and easy to hike. From the top of the Mountain you can see from mountain range to the next range. The spectacular views are at dawn and sunset.

Do you like boat rides? Gates of the Mountains is located 20 miles north of Helena. The tour follows the Lewis and Clark expedition route on the Missouri River. \$15 for wizened senior adults and \$20 for the young unknowing. Reservations are recommended.
