TECHNICAL TIPS

The tires and wheels on your Airstream are key elements of a safe journey. Proper tire care is critical to ensure your adventures go off without a hitch!




Regular inspection of your wheels and tires should be an essential part of your safety review routine. One of the most important habits is to tighten your lug nuts. By design your Airstream trailer wheels carry higher loads that a typical passenger vehicle or truck. Checking your owner's manual for the maximum pounds for each is helpful to understanding load and weight. Trailer wheels can be subject to high stress as you navigate the curves and turns of the road and backing into those angular sights!

Lug nuts are designed to clamp the wheel, brake rotor and wheel hub together, which transmits braking torque to the wheel on deceleration and drives torque from the engine and transmission. Engineers design lug nuts to achieve a specific clamping force – or bolt tension.

Use a torque wrench set to the proper pound/weight. Do not try to tighten by hand or with an impact wrench. Torque wrenches are set to click or beep at a specific torque value, so the same torque can be applied to all the lug nuts and ensuring an even clamping force.

Tightening lug nuts the wrong way can cause problems, some of which may not be immediately noticeable.

- Under torque could result in losing a wheel
- Over torque can stretch the wheel stud, possible breaking it or causing vibration.
- Uneven torque (each lug nut torqued differently) can cause vibration.



Torquing should be done in a star pattern.

There are two schools of thought on the procedure for torquing. The first has you "loosening" the bolt before applying the torque pressure. The second groups does not believe it is necessary to loosen. You decide based on your own research.

For Airstream trailers with aluminum wheels, the recommended setting for your torque wrench is 110 pound-feet. Older steel wheeled trailers are typically set at 100 pound-feet.

Tightening lug nights is essential every time your replace a wheel or put new tires on your Airstream. Airstream recommends torquing at 10, 25 & 50 miles after replacement. It is also recommended to check your lugs before each trip.
