BOONDOCKING WITH A CPAP

So, are you one of the many CPAP users out there? But, what about those nights where you do not have access to shore power? Even the quietest of generators are very annoying not only to you, but to everyone around you. There are some great Federal lands for boondocking, but they only allow 2 hours of generator usage in the morning and 2 hours in the evening. And now to add to that, we have urban rallies growing in popularity! With that said, let me offer several ideas that have worked for me.

First - Invest in an inverter. A good battery will power your CPAP all night, even if it has a humidifier. Most newer trailers have one built in. If not, an inverter can be an inexpensive upgrade. Some inverters are just the plug-and-play type using a 12volt power outlet. My CPAP uses 80 watts, even less if you turn off the humidifier. (This is only 53-amp hours at 12- volts for an 8-hour night). Also, there are small travel type CPAP machines that draw even less current.

Second - I have a power cord that plugs directly into a 12-volt power outlet. I found mine on Amazon. This is also helpful if the spouse is driving and you need a nap while riding in the passenger seat.

Third - For off-grid camping, in my baby Airstream, I have a battery powered CPAP. My model is no longer made but there are others. Some manufacturers have battery packs for your current machine. Batteries are usually good for up to 13 hours. This is what I use in the National Parks. They get really testy if you run a generator after 10pm. The next day, you just recharge it. I am not promoting any company here, (you choose that) but there are options found at <u>cpap.com</u>.

Boondocking is a great way to connect with nature. Especially those cool, clear nights with the windows open and the sounds of nature luring you to sleep. With a little research and creativity, you can make boondocking a more pleasant and peaceful experience for yourself and everyone around you.

Recipe unknown

Simply Delicious Fudge

Ingredients:

- 3 cups semisweet chocolate chips
- 1 can (14 oz.) sweetened condensed milk
- 4 Tbsp. unsalted butter
- 1 tsp. vanilla (or other) extract of your choice

Instructions:

- 1. Heat milk and chips in microwave, uncovered, in a bowl for 2 minutes.
- 2. Remove and stir until smooth.
- 3. Stir in butter and extract.
- 4. Microwave another 30 seconds and pour into a 12 x 12 greased pan.
- 5. Chill for 2 hours.

NOTE: If you'd like you can add 1 cup cranberries or nuts to the mixture, prior to pouring into the pan.
