## **Boondocking Tips for the April Rally**

All tips are courtesy of "Google"

- Arrive with your fresh water tank full, and your black and grey tanks empty.
- Preplan meals and prepare them ahead of your trip, then freeze meals. (less cleanup and less dishes)
- ◆ Cook with gas on stove, or grill. (no need to run generator for microwave)
- Bring bottled water for drinking and cooking.
- Prewash fruits and vegetables at home. (Save water)
- ◆ Wash dishes once a day, in a basin, then dump in toilet. (helps to keep grey water tank from filling too quickly)
- ◆ Take a "navy shower". (get wet, stop water at shower head, soap up, rinse)
- ◆ If sunny, pull down inside shades, and use awnings.
- ◆ Decrease your amount of trash. (use cloth napkins, and dish cloths instead of paper)
- Leave your site cleaner than you found it.
