Discounted rates have been negotiated. We'll all be parked in the same area, close to facilities. It's a good stroll to the hall, available throughout our stay. The hall is licensed, meaning that any alcohol we consume there must be purchased from the bar.

**Friday highlights:** Kelly's Food Truck, one of Kingston's most popular, will be on site for dinner. In the evening we will be visited by Phil Jenkins, an Ottawa-based author and musician. Phil hails from Liverpool England but has called the Ottawa area home for many years. #### WALLY BYAM CARAVAN CLUB INTERNATIONAL

DIRECTIONS:

#### APPLICATION OF RED MEMBERSHIP RECOGNITION STARS

The scale diagram below illustrates the proper way to apply the stars to your Afrstream. Only one side of the space where the WBCCI logo is located is shown, the right side. The first star for five years membership should be at the right of the logo, the second star for the second five years at the left of the logo and so on. We hope that you will have many opportunities to add more stars as your club membership years accumulate.

#### READ CAREFULLY BEFORE APPLYING STARS

- With a soft lead pencil, draw a horizontal line through the center of the logo using a yardstick or long straightedge. Refer to the diagram below. We suggest that you begin with the rear of your Airstream.
- Measure out from the right edge of the logo 3 inches along the pencil line and make a verticle line about 3" long. If applying 2 stars, repeat on the left side of the logo.
- 3. If more than two stars are to be applied, measure out 4" additional and make another verticle line as in #2 above. Repeat on left side for a fourth star. If not applying more than two stars, skip this step.
- 4. Holding a star in position, draw around it with a pencil. This will help prepare for step #5.
- 5. Carefully remove the backing from one star and place it within the outline marked in step #4. Refer to diagram for correct positioning. Caution, the stars stick quickly and are hard to move thereafter.
- 6. Repeat steps #4 and #5 for each additional star to be applied.



- Repeat the process above for the application of the stars to the front of your Airstream
- Remember, if you should sell your Airstream that the stars should be removed as well as the membership numbers and the club logo.

Departing from the Region 2 Rally in Kingston, Ontario on May 26, this will be an unhurried trip across southern Ontario and the USA with 2- or 3-night stops at every campground. The route will cross Ontario, Michigan, Indiana, Illinois, Missouri, Kansas and Colorado.

There will be a good mix of organized activities and free time to explore or shop on your own, as well as lots of social time, happy hours and cookouts to get to know and enjoy your fellow caravanners. ### Hudson-Mohawk Installation Rally 2020

To see site information, including photos of each site, go to <u>www.Fishcreekpond.com</u> Go to "Campsite Photo Guide" tab, then, click on "Choose Site" on left side of page.

We're going to try for the sites on the peninsula, sites A1-A22. They are the inner sites. Shoreline sites along the peninsula are walk-in sites only during our rally days. I believe that means that although you cannot reserve those shoreline sites, if you've reserved an inner site, you might be able to trade that reserved inner site for a shoreline site when you get there, if there's one available.

Watch the trailer length of the site you pick. Most A sites are up to 40 foot trailers, but a few are 30 foot and Site A20 says only up to 20 foot. I'm going to try for site A18, to try to get in the middle of things.

This is a NY State campground with *dry camping only*. NO electric, water or sewer hook-ups. They have a dump station and there are quite a few water outlets available on the peninsula. Generators are allowed up to 5 hours per day from 9am to 11am and 4 to 7pm.
