
I've included the links to 2 YouTube videos. One is on BRN's and Rallies and the other is on RV electricity and Lithium batteries.

However, on this day in November, eighteen of my Hudson Mohawk friends chose not to bypass Amsterdam but rather to share a meal, a story, and a smile at this gem of a restaurant that still endures.

The Centre County Grange Encampment & Fair better known as 'The Grange Fair' is the location for our 2024 Region 2 Rally. This area is best known as the home of Penn State University. From beautiful waterfalls to historic buildings, caverns to museums -- they can all be yours to explore in Centre County!



Nearby Bald Eagle State Park is one of the most-visited state parks in the area. The 1,730-acre lake laps the flanks of Bald Eagle Mountain, surrounded by forests, fields, and wetlands. If you are into trains or biking, there is the abandoned Coburn Railroad Tunnel. Penn's Cave in Centre County offers the only cavern tour in the United States that is conducted completely by boat. Woodward Cave contains 5 large rooms, hundreds of yards of tunnels and passageways and the largest stalagmite in Pennsylvania! https://www.pennscave.com/




