I. History & Overview of Airstream & Airstream Club International

- Wally Byam opens small trailer factory in Culver City, CA in 1931 with first public sale of trailers in 1932; Wally dubs them "Airstreams" because they cruise down the road "like a stream of air" the start of a truly great American success story!
- In 1955 in eastern Canada, about 100 Airstream caravaners formed the Wally Byam
 Caravan Club (now commonly known as Airstream Club International) and have been
 promoting Airstream adventure ever since. ACI has over 16,000 members across North
 American and other portions of the globe, 12 Regions and over 100 local units like Utah's
 Wasatch Airstream Club. We owe a huge debt of gratitude to Helen Byam Schwamborn,
 one of the 80 charter members, who organized and supported the club until 1979.
- Like America, Airstreamers undertook great challenges starting with caravans to Central America (1951), Mexico (1952), Western Canada (1954), Eastern Canada (1955), Europe (1956, 1960), Cuba (1956, 1958), Capetown to Cairo (1959-60), Around the World (Singapore to Portugal overland, 1963-64), and Jamaica (1970), to mention a few. The pinnacle of challenges was Cape Town to Cairo, a grueling journey across Africa where the group was greeted with cheers "Viva Wally Byam" as they "zigzagged over desert, through jungle and swamp" (Lillie B. Douglas, Cape Town to Cairo, 1959 book)
- Today's Airstream Club International reflects that same desire for adventure as demonstrated by Wally Byam, Helen Byam Schwamborn, and other AS pioneers.
