In addition to the activities at Grand Vue Park and the Moundsville area, just 12.5 miles north on Route 2 is the Historical Wheeling, West Virginia. Known as the birthplace of West Virginia, the first State Capital, and an early industrial hub along the Ohio River. Wheeling holds a unique place in American history. Its designation by Congress as a [National Heritage Area](#) provides an effective way to tell the stories of its rich cultural past and to conserve its natural and historic resources.
