Admission to the Peru, IN (Circus Capital of the World!)

Amateur Circus! Every year approximately 200 young people, ages 7 to 21, present ten circus performances during an eight-day festival in mid-July. Kiddie, Junior, Adult Clowns, the 'Best Circus Band in All the Land, and a huge number of volunteers, join to support these talented performers. Dating back to the late 1800s, many of the country's most famous circuses over-wintered a few miles southeast of Peru. That area is now home to the famous International Circus Hall of Fame. Performances were held in a tent until 1968 when the show moved inside the permanent three-ring building near the center of town. The popular circus museum, ticket and general offices, and souvenir shop are also located in the building.



Recipe Round Up ~ Cilantro Lime Grilled Chicken Tacos

Prep Time: 5 min Cook Time: 25 min Marinate: 30 min Total Time: 1 hour

Servings: 4, unless very hungry, then 2!

Using a quick citrus marinade, these grilled chicken tacos offer a blast of summer flavor. To make campsite prep easier, you can make cilantro lime marinade ahead of time and store in small container in your cooler or fridge.

INGREDIENTS: CILANTRO LIME MARINADE:

- © 2 TB chopped cilantro
- © 2 limes juice + zest
- § 1 tsp salt
- 1 tsp chili powder
- § 1 tsp cumin

- ∞ 1 TB oil

TACO ASSEMBLY:

- s tortillas
- s pico de gallo
- cheese
- © cilantro

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. **Prepare marinade:** Mix **oil**, **lime** juice, zest, **cilantro** and **spices** together in a small bowl (*this can be done at home*). Place **chicken** into an airtight container or sealable bag and pour marinade over, shaking to ensure chicken is coated evenly. Marinate for at least 30 mins (an hour is better), or up to two hours.
- 2. Prepare a grill or campfire for grilling.
- 3. Remove chicken from marinade and place it on grill. Cook until internal temp reaches 165F, turning as needed to ensure even cooking (approx 5-8 mins on each side). Remove from heat and chop into bite-sized pieces.
- 4. To assemble tacos, layer chicken, pico de gallo, cheese, and fresh cilantro into tortillas (warmed over the grill if you'd prefer!) and enjoy. Optional: sour cream, salsa.
