On June 21, 1971 the Charter Oak CT Unit was welcomed into WBCCI and our club was Chartered. Region 1 President John Engel presented the Charter to President Emile Raboin.

The first organizational meeting was held on October 11,1970 with 23 couples attending. Most of these early Airstreamers belonged to Berkshire New York unit, when at WBCCI functions we were asked where in New York we lived. Thus the forming of COCU. New England was the other unit and it was huge in size. The 1971 International Rally was held in Salem, Oregon, nine trailer from COCU attended, receiving our Charter and a third place in July 4th parade for our float for originality, a first time for a :"baby unit".




