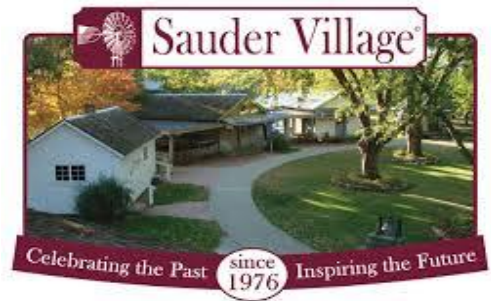


NOVA Explore Ohio Rally 1.0 at Sauder Village

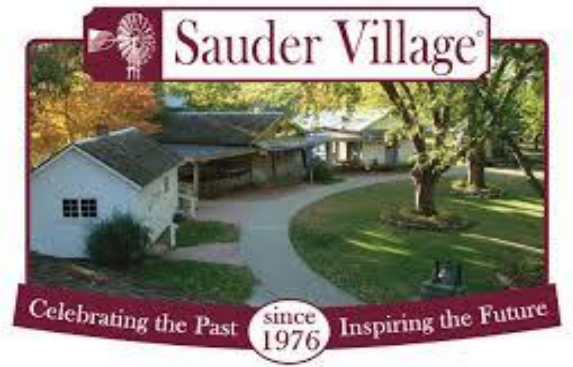
Rally and Other Fees

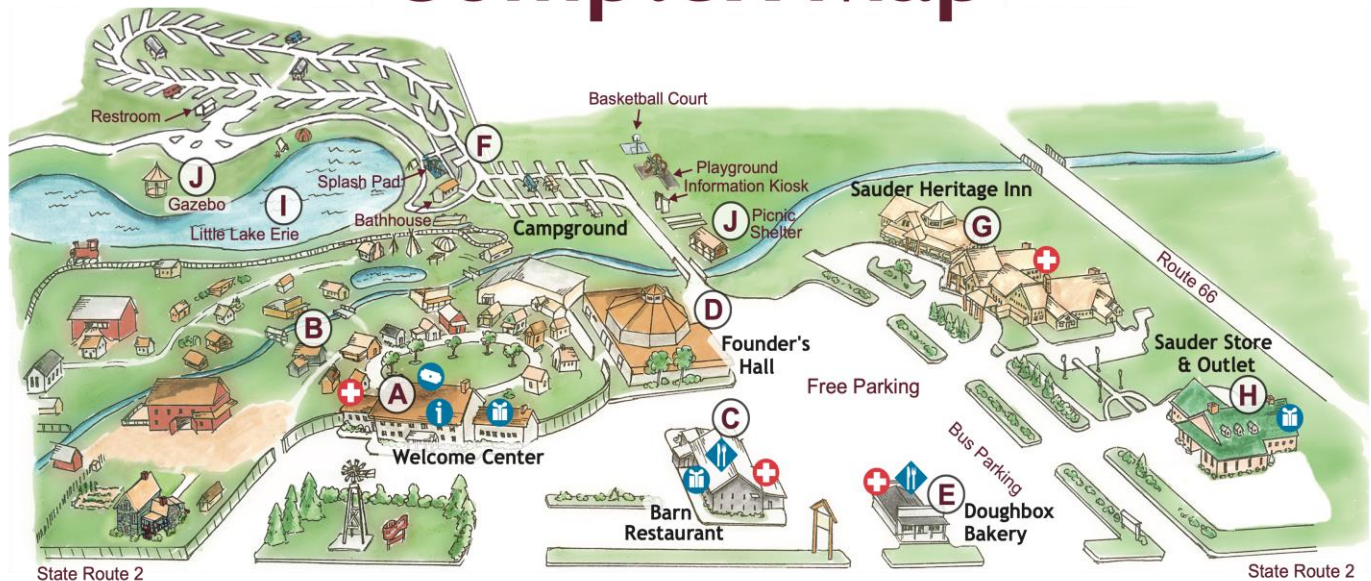

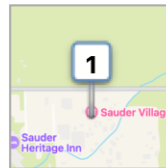
