Hello fellow Washington Airstream Club members! I am an Army veteran and former senior director of engineering for PNW-based international software manufacturer who grew up in an Airstream-loving family in Ohio.

I joined the Washington Airstream Club in 2018 when I purchased a 25-foot International Serenity while training to become a doctor of clinical psychology. Initially, I volunteered to help with updates for social media and served on the grievance committee.
