# The President's Cast

The INWAC board and leadership team started the season with the intent of fostering memorable experiences for our members. Our planning and working with gracious rally hosts have resulted in an excellent start to the 2024 travel season with five rally venues behind us, and five venues plus a Canadian caravan to go. Not surprisingly, the newly formed rally committee (Suzanne Caron and Andrea Lloyd) are already planning 2025 rally venues!

We learned from Joan Pittenger & Bruce Harruff that April is not too early to get started with a great turnout, memorable outings, and great food at the Tulip Festival in Mt. Vernon. Despite the hosting casino having a cybersecurity breach and being partially closed, Airstreamers were able to roll in and we spent the week visiting tulip fields, hiking and biking at Anacortes regional nature sites, and of course topped-off most days with great food and wine at local restaurant venues in La Conner and Anacortes.

The second big event for INWAC was the Region 10 rally at Blackwell Island in Coeur d'Alene. INWAC was the local hosting club and our members invested their time to make the rally a success for Region 10 members, local community stores, and especially the CDA UGM Women and Children's Center. The attending members gave great post-rally feedback, stores were appreciative of our business, and the CDA Women and Children's Center received \$11,000 that was raised by the rally donation efforts. Thank you so much to the INWAC and other R10 volunteers that enabled such a great event!

For the folks that couldn't make the Tulip Festival Rally or were unable to get into the R10 rally in CDA, the Little Diamond Rally has proven to be an annual local venue warm-up rally hosted by Dave and Linda Johnson. Dave - pass along our thanks to your sister and brotherin-law for hosting us at their house for homemade pizza and boat rides on Diamond Lake.

Due to exorbitant RV site cost, the Lake Chelan Rally was replaced with a rally in Prosser, WA followed by a mini rally in Walla Walla. Prosser Wine Country RV Park lived up to its name with members enjoying outings to local wineries. Andrea Lloyd and Becky Amend hosted a special night of hands-on homemade pasta making. Some of us think Walla Walla should always be considered as an annual rally venue due to the close proximity to town, wineries, and food venues. We were also treated to a great potluck barbeque at Tim Werner's house.

The Nugget Rally brought us to halfway through the season and Rich Doering attracted 11 Airstreamers to the St. Regis, Montana venue. For those considering hosting, Rich has proven that not everything has to be scripted and planned. Hosting a rally can actually be a very non-stressful event. If the venue is rich in attractions, people still assimilate for daily outings, fishing, and food get togethers. The weather taxed our air conditioners, however, the evenings were filled with conversation between INWAC regulars and affiliates. I hope Rich keeps the St. Regis Nugget Rally on our annual calendar.

We have five more rallies and a month-long caravan ahead of us. At this halfway point, I encourage each of you to have your tow vehicle serviced and spend a bit more time on Airstream maintenance. There are online guides recommending 60/90/180 day maintenance. Airstream recommends focus on serviceability of your tires, lug nut torque, battery health, cleaning/replacing air conditioning filters, replacing water filters, testing smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, and focus on recommended lubrication points. We want all members to travel safely, so please spend just a little bit of time going through the maintenance procedures in your manual. I also personally recommend each person purchase the RV version of the California duster. I know each of you have a little bit of OCD in you!

Thanks to all the volunteers that have made this season a success so far! Deb and I will see most of you at the remaining rallies or on the Canadian Caravan.




