Recipe of the Month

This is one of my go to recipes

Olive Garden Chicken Pasta

Ingredients

1 1/2 pounds Chicken Breast (I have also used thighs, boneless skinless)
16 ounce Olive Garden Italian dressing
1/2 cup grated Parmesan
8 ounces Cream Cheese
16 ounces uncooked Pasta

Instructions

- Place the chicken breasts in the bottom of the slow cooker.
- In a bowl, mix the Olive Garden dressing, Parmesan, black pepper, and minced garlic until combined. Pour over the chicken.
- Place the block of cream cheese on top of the chicken.
- Cover and cook on high for 4 hours or low for 6 hours, until chicken is tender.
- Cook the penne pasta according to package directions until al dente. Drain and set aside.
- Using two forks, shred the chicken in the slow cooker, mixing it with the creamy sauce.
- Add the cooked penne to the slow cooker and stir gently to coat the pasta in the chicken and sauce.
- Serve warm, topped with extra Parmesan cheese if desired.
