# **Apple Picking**

Whether you will be on your way home from Alumapalooza, on your way to Sedalia, MO, or just coming from home, you will enjoy the Apple Pickin' Time Rally September 11 - 15 at Fort Mountain State Park.

Preliminary on site schedule for the Apple picking rally.

Thursday - Potluck breakfast at host site or pavilion depending on weather.

Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday, happy hour, 4:00pm at host site, or pavilion, depending on weather. Light or heavy hors d'oeuvres to be determined.

Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Get acquainted meetings at host site starting at 7:30pm. Bourbon, wine etc sharing. Solo stove fire. We may need one additional solo stove plus firewood.

All dinners are on your own. There will be no scheduled potluck dinners. Those wishing to join together for dinner can gather at the host site at 6:00pm or at the pavilion depending on weather. If at the host site please bring chairs and a small table. If gathering at the pavilion picnic tables are on site. One pop up canopy will be available at the host site, we may need a second one if someone has one.

On site activities at Fort Mountain State Park are:

- Thirteen Hiking trails.
- Three black diamond biking trails.
- Nine horse trails.
- One 18 hole miniature golf course.

Outside of the park, are three nearby cities to visit. The closest is Chatsworth Georgia, which offers axe throwing, knife throwing, darts etc. Chatsworth also has the closest Ingles grocery store at 7 miles from the park. Also, in Chatsworth is the Chief Vann House State Historic Site. It is the largest, most prosperous plantation in the Cherokee Nation.

In Blue Ridge we have both fine and casual dining, antique stores, high-end galleries, and a couple of brew houses. There is also a scenic railway tour that departs from Blue Ridge and travels to Copper Hill Tennessee and back.

In Ellijay, we have fine and casual dining, as well as a variety of antique stores and a couple of galleries. In the general area, there are several Apple orchards, thus the name, The Apple Picking Rally.
