You must obtain an [FCC Registration Number \(FRN\)](#) from the FCC prior to the exam. There is no cost to obtain an FRN. The exam fee is \$15.00, cash preferred, payable when you take the exam. The VE will inform you whether you passed or failed the exam and submit your exam to the FCC. When the applicant pays \$35 to the FCC, a license will be issued via email.
