Lights at Stephen Foster Part 2 12/9 to 12/11



The Stephen Foster Folk Culture Center State Park is situated on the banks of the legendary Suwannee River near White Springs, FL. (*NOTE: it is not the same park as the one in Georgia with a similar name*).

Arrive Mon. 12/9 and depart Wed. 12/11.

The Stephen Foster Folk Culture Center State Park features a holiday light display, museum about Foster's most famous songs, 97-bell carillon (under repairs), hiking, bicycling, canoeing and wildlife viewing.

Registration opens up for Florida residents 11 months in advance (non-Florida residents 10 months), so make your reservations early at https://reserve.floridastateparks.org/ After you have secured your campsite, then register for the rally at https://airstreamclub.org/florida/rallies-and-events. There is no rally fee for this 2 night event.

On Monday night we are planning on holding a happy hour to meet each other and then driving through the park's light tour. Tuesday is an activity day (paddling, biking, or exploring) with a potluck dinner that evening.

Devil's Den Spring in Williston, Florida. March 31, to April 7, 2025

We are planning a week-long buddy rally starting March 31-April 7 at Devil's Den in Williston, Florida. Located on the edge of Levy County, Marion County and nearby Alachua, there is a multitude of activities, from Cedar Key to Rainbow Springs and Paynes Prairie.

We recently spent a weekend snorkeling in the karst cavern and felt like a weekend was just not enough. Cedar Lake Woods and Gardens is next door, and if you enjoy gardens this is not to be missed. Another day might be spent at the most beautiful Kanapaha Botanical Gardens in Gainesville. A visit to the University of Florida Natural History Museum is a must where you can see a fully intact fossil skeleton of a Tremarco's Floridanus, an extinct species of bear dating back 10,000 years geological evidence which dates Devil's Den to be between 10,000 and 75,000 years old. Hiking Paynes Prairie, Devil's Millhopper, Sweetwater Wetlands Park are some of the other activities we will be planning. Ichetucknee and Santa Fe Rivers are also nearby, with the Springs Institute in High Springs a worthy visit.

To lock into the weekly rate of \$225.00, book online soon because it is first come first serve and they will hold that rate until this year's end. When registering, be sure to put AIRSTREAM CLUB in the space that reads company name. There are 32 sites. We are looking for some co-hosts, love to have new club members that have not hosted before, to step up to lead an activity or host a meal.
