Day One: Just as sure as every time a bell rings, an angel gets their wings, Airstreams will begin rolling in on Wednesday. **Check-in starts at 3:00 PM**, and you'll be welcomed by a host fresh from the Island of Misfit Toys. Set up your trailer, decorate if you'd like (Charlie Brown trees are welcome), and get ready for a few days of good food and great friends. Happy hour will kick off daily at 5:00 PM, and attendees will be assigned to bring an appetizer to share either Wednesday or Friday evening. At 7:00 PM, The Kitchen Store will be on-site offering a fabulous demonstration for all you avid cooks. At 9:00 PM, we'll have campfire caroling, because as you know, the best way to spread Christmas Cheer, is singing loud for all to hear.

Information and Registration Instructions for the December “It’s a Wonderful Rally”

December Rally Cost Information

- Rally fee per person: \$10
- Parking fee per night: \$66
- Thursday Group Wine Tasting: Drytown Cellars \$6.00 per person
- Thursday Chili dinner (part of cook-off) \$7 per person for sides, etc. provided by hosts.
- Friday LRC game - 3 \$1 bills gets you entry to game on Friday night
- Saturday Mexican Dinner - \$29 per person

Registration for this rally opens at 9 a.m. on October 1, 2024. At that time, you may access the Jotform registration page via the Club’s webpage <https://airstreamclub.org/norcal-2024-installation-rally> or this link:

Attendees are chosen on a first-come, first serve basis based on the time the completed Jotform is sent to the registrar. After completing and sending the Jotform, wait for an email *from the registrar* confirming that you are registered for the rally, and the amount you owe. At that point, you may either pay for the rally via Zelle to the NorCal Airstream Club (initiate through Zelle App or bank app if your bank participates) or send a check for the full amount directly to the registrar. If you pay by check, make your checks payable to “WBCCI/NorCal” and mail directly to Lori Bibby, 3029 Black Hawk Lane, Lincoln, CA 95648. If you want to pay via Zelle but do not know how or if your bank participates, check out: <https://www.zellepay.com/>. If you do not hear back from the registrar on the day you register, contact her within 48 hours at: NorCalregistrar3854@gmail.com. If you are placed on the waitlist, do not pay until you hear from the registrar that you are confirmed for the rally. She will let you know your status.

Refund Policy: The park’s cancellation policy: “Deadline for RV Park cancellation is 14 days prior to your arrival date. Within 14 days, the RV Park will charge one night stay.” However, if you cancel and there is someone on the wait list to take your spot within the 14 day period, a refund for the site will be issued. Deadline for cancelling meals is two weeks prior to the start of the rally, that is November 20, 2024. After that date, meals funds will not be refunded. Contact the registrar to cancel meals. Please contact the Rally Registrar if you have ANY changes to your registration or wish to register after the deadline. Best to email at: NorCalregistrar3854@gmail.com She will contact you as soon as she can. **Under no circumstances are members to contact the RV Park with changes or cancellations.**

Note: Your registration is incomplete and not fully confirmed until we receive BOTH your registration and payment. Typically, Zelle payments will confirm your registration quicker than sending in a check. Do not wait until the last minute to pay or you may not have a site regardless of when you initially apply. **If using Zelle, make sure to add your name, rally location, and how you accessed Zelle in the “memo” or “message” area before sending payment.**

The park’s Pet Policy is as follows: “We are a pet-friendly resort but pets may not disturb other guests, and must be cleaned up after by owners. Pets must always be on a leash and restrained when not confined inside an RV, and no pet may be left unattended outside of an RV, even on the site or if restrained. **There is a maximum of two pets per reservation** with a \$50 non-refundable fee per reservation for any pet in a vacation or cottage rental. Pets are the responsibility of the owner. If management determines that a pet is disruptive or aggressive, they have sole discretion to require the guest to restrict the pet's behavior or location, or remove the pet from the resort. If a guest is unwilling or unable to restrict the pet or have it removed from the resort, as requested by management, management has the right to immediately terminate the guest's reservation and evict the guest from the resort, without refund. **All pets must also be up to date on vaccines, and copies of pet vaccine records must be available upon request.** Upon check-in, you are required to notify the office of your pets if you have not already added them to your reservation during the booking process.” Please adhere to this policy.

Finally, If you are ill or not feeling well, please stay home and get better. Thank you for your courtesy in this regard.
