Recipe Round Up ~ Renée's Winning Buckeye White Chicken Chili

This is the Chili Cook Off Award winning recipe!

Prep: 10 Min Cook: 8 Hours

Ingredients:

- 1 pound of chicken (organic)
- ❖ 32 ounces of low sodium chicken broth
- 1 package of McCormick White Chicken Chili Mix
- ❖ 1 can Rotel Mild
- 2 cans of Bushes Beans Chili Starter (Campfire) *the secret*
- 1 Teaspoon garlic powder
- Shake of black pepper to your liking
- ❖ 1 cup Pepper Jack shredded cheese
- ❖ Add freshly chopped garlic, & jalapeño diced to your tastebuds

Instructions:

- 1. Add all ingredients with the exception of the cheese to a crockpot and simmer on low for 8 hours. Make sure to stir periodically while cooking!
- 2. Pull the chicken out and shred accordingly on a cutting board & add back into crockpot.
- 3. Add pepper jack shredded cheese.

Serve with either crackers or tortilla chips topped with additional cheese! You can never have enough!


