Tell them you are with the Missouri Greater Ozark Club. They are not set up to handle credit cards, you will need to mail a check for one night to reserve your site. Be sure to get the mailing address to send check to. \$35 a night with full hookups and concrete pad for parking. Please let your host

There are many activities available in Hermann, including a Trolley (hop on- hop off style) that visits several wineries and breweries - \$25 per person for the day. AND – Hermann Farm Heritage Festival on Saturday from 10am to 5pm. Demonstrations of traditional crafts, live music, horse drawn carriage rides, Shire draft horses, quilt display and more. Tickets are \$12 per person, or you can get them online for \$10 at [hermannfarm.org](http://hermannfarm.org).

And of course, following Hermann in October is the International Airstream Rally in Sedalia, MO. Jane and I will be arriving early on 1 October – Jane is in the Chorus. Hope to see you 'all there.
