How to Find, Sign Up and Pay for an ACI Event Online

- Log on to https://airstreamclub.org/
- Click on the EVENTS tab
- A map of the US will be displayed containing pins for all the events for all the Airstream clubs. Just above the map on the right side of the screen is the Clubs box. Click on the down arrow to display the list of clubs then scroll down to Watchung NJ Club. Clicking on this will cause the map to display only Watchung club events.
- Find the event you wish to sign up for and click on the associated pin.
- A text box giving a brief description of the event will be displayed. Click on the arrow in the orange box that says More.
- A new page will be displayed. If a registration form has been created for the event this page will give you two options: online registration or mailin registration using a download of the form. The online form allows payment via PayPal. If you prefer to pay via check download and print the form, which includes payment instructions. If there is no registration form available yet one will

Hillbilly Cooking

This month's breakfast recipe was suggested by our 2025 President Leslie DeHerde. Do you have tried-and-true camping recipes? Please send your favorites to the editor (dconley1810@gmail.com).

Crock Pot Overnight Breakfast Casserole

Feeds twelve. (When would you need to serve 12 or more people? When you're hosting a rally!)

Ingredients:

Cooking oil spray

One dozen eggs

1 cup milk

2 pounds frozen or refrigerated hash brown potatoes, either diced or shredded

1 pound diced ham

8 ounces shredded cheese

Directions

- 1. Spray crock pot liner with cooking oil
- 2. Beat eggs together with milk
- 3. Place 1/3 of potatoes in the crock pot liner
- 4. Add 1/3 of diced ham
- 5. Add 1/3 of shredded cheese
- 6. Repeat these three layers twice more each time using 1/3 of the ingredients ending with the last of the cheese on top
- 7. Pour egg mixture over the layers
- 8. Place lid on crockpot and turn on low.
- 9. Cook for 6-7 hours if using defrosted/refrigerated hash browns, eight hours if using frozen.

For more complex flavors,

- Finely chop one large or two medium red or yellow onions and add 1/3 on top of each potato layer
- Finely chop one green pepper and add to each potato layer
- Add ¼ teaspoon of dry mustard and/or ¼ teaspoon of garlic powder to the egg mixture

Alternatives:

Sliced brown-and-serve sausages, or precooked bacon, instead of ham Meatless sausage or bacon Soy or almond milk Non-dairy cheese
