I remember the year when my cousin's family decided they weren't going to celebrate Christmas. No tree, no gifts, no Santa Claus. They have three children and at the time the youngest was about 8. She is my goddaughter, and she still believed in Santa. I was devastated for them all. As I scrambled to figure out how to save Christmas, their mother was insistent. I ran out and bought them each a small tree complete with ornaments and a manger. By the time I got there, Sydney crawled up on the couch with me and quietly shared that her brother had told her there was no such

thing as Santa. There were tears welling up in her eyes. I looked up and silently asked God to give me the words.

"Sydney, I said, there's a secret you need to know. You see, Santa is the spirit of Christmas. It is true that he doesn't fly around in a sled dropping presents down your chimney, but he is very much alive and well. Your brother must have thought you were responsible enough to keep the secret. You see, now that you know, you actually become Santa for others."

She looked at me with eyes wide as I explained, "It's a big responsibility and I hope you're up for it." She nodded. "Now that you know," I said, "You get to be the spirit of Christmas for others. You get to do nice things and give gifts...but you must never tell where they came from. Do you think you can do that?" She nodded again and I put my finger to my lips. "Shhhh," I said. "Santa will live in you as long as you want him to." "So you still believe in him?" She asked. "Very much." I said.

Airstreamers remind me of this story every day of the year. The spirit of this community, its helpful people, and the kindness shown over and over to strangers keeps the spirit of Christmas alive all year. Here's a story you might not know:

Alummalina is a rally planned by one couple that had been held in Marion, North Carolina for 17 years. This year would have been 18, but several weeks before the rally, well, you know what happened in North Carolina. Tom Johnson's RV park is gone and with it went the plans for the 18th Alummalina. But here's the thing with a rally that big...planning a fish fry, continental breakfasts, food, entertainment, and probably 100 other things I haven't thought of, costs money. John and Susan Leak had this down to a science and they knew that the rally fee would cover them...unless, of course, the campground was buried under a sea of mud and the rally is cancelled. I was on the list for that rally, and I receive exactly one email about this. They were a bit worried about the fish vendor. That's all they said, amongst their extreme disappointment in announcing the cancellation. My heart sunk for them. But this is Airstream, where hope and joy live.

Within a day, a "gofundme" was started and within 3 days, \$14,000 was raised, far exceeding the goal. The extra funds will help rebuild, both Alummalina and the campground. Santa is alive and well.

Keystone Apple Festival Rally




