# Signing Up For A Rally

Does the rally sign up process have you confused? We have people that have expressed some consternation with the rally enrollment process. Below are a couple things to think about when signing up.

Given the size of our reservations, usually 25 – 40 trailer sites needed, our 1<sup>st</sup> VP needs to arrange rallies a year in advance. Only State and County Parks have a 6-month time window to make the necessary reservations. Not only do many campgrounds require the year advanced reservation, but the park may also require that GBAAC provide a roster of attendees within 30 days of making the reservation. This 30-day roster requirement means GBAAC needs to send out a sign-up notice a year in advance.

The challenge for all of us is the ability to predict what we are doing a year in advance. Because of this, if you do not manage to get into a rally at the first announcement, please get on the waitlist. Every rally has cancellations as the rally date gets closer and it is generally not too late to sign up for the waitlist.

Ask questions. Contact the 1<sup>st</sup> VP, or if there is a Rally Host listed, ask them how long the waitlist is. Many people initially on the waitlist drop off although the rally host may not know that. Just be persistent and in many cases you will be successful attending a rally you want to go to.

Sign up to be a host! Hosts are allowed to sign up before the rally is announced to the rest of the group. It would be bad if the host could not attend their own rally. Peruse the rally schedule on this newsletter and see if there is one that you would like to host. There are many other members willing to co-host and show you the ropes. The club board is here to support you as a host so give hosting a try.

Lastly, sign up for other rallies. NorCal, Central Coast, Region 12 and ACI all have rallies. As you attend the larger rallies, Region 12 for instance, those are rallies that have 150 Airstreams from multiple states. Annual International Rallies may take time getting to, but sharing ideas and experiences are the best part of those rallies. Not lastly, there are National Rallies such as the Rose Parade Rally. We know from experience this rally is fantastic. Look at the ACI website and you will see a wide variety of rally opportunities.

Being an ACI member you automatically get a Harvest Hosts membership. Harvest Hosts are farms, dairies, wineries, etc... that allow members camp at their facilities. It is usually boondocking but generally very inexpensive. There may not be a camping fee, but you will be expected to buy some of the host's products in exchange for staying there. Some do offer water or electricity, but those can be a nominal fee.

Target getting on a waitlist if a rally is "sold out". Try attending other clubs' rallies. Expand your horizons to the opportunities from ACI to Harvest Hosts and you will end up with a rich camping experience.
