Annual Meeting Business

Last month the Florida Airstream Club had to cancel their annual meeting due storm damage at the planned campgrounds. So the votes on last year's annual meeting minutes, Election of Officers, changes to the constitution was done online and a quorum was met.

The results are as follows:

- 1. Minutes of 2023 annual meeting were approved
- 2. Candidates for the President and Treasurer positions were approved (Mike McGinn and Bruce Fafard)
- 3. Amendments to the Florida Airstream Club Constitution were approved.
 - A. Reworded process to become affiliate members to fit the current method on the international website.
 - B. Removed Second Vice President and Trustees from the Executive Board.
 - C. Added vacant positions shall be filled by a majority vote of the Executive Board.
 - D. Changed annual business meeting from October to no later than December 1st.
 - E. Changed when constitutional amendments may be amended to any business meeting rather than only at annual or special meetings, providing a notice is provided to all members at least 15 days prior to the meeting.

After the election closed, Beccy Hosoda stepped up to volunteer to serve as our Vice President and Gina McGinn volunteered to serve as our Secretary (pending current Executive Board approval).

Cracker Christmas & Installation of Officers — Part I 12/5 to 12/9



As everyone is getting prepared for the holiday season, I wanted to let you know that I appreciate your volunteer spirit for the upcoming rally at Fort Christmas. I know we're all going to get busy, but it is one of the most fun rallies we have been to, because you get to meet so many locals, with such rich history and stories to share about the houses we will be watching. If this is your first time, I want to welcome you to your inaugural officer installation and volunteer rally. It will be a blast and I promise, you'll hardly have had more fun working with others than you will here. If you are returning, I appreciate your service spirit and dedication to helping them have a wonderful festival.

Cracker Christmas is only 2-ish weeks away! If your plans have changed and you're not able to make it, please let me know. We have two or three more spots open, so if you have some Airstream friends, let them know. Please plan to arrive on Thursday, December, 5th, between 12:00 - 4:00 pm and stay until Monday morning if possible. Friday arrivals are also acceptable. Note that arrivals and departures are not permitted during the festival hours on Saturday and Sunday (due to the traffic and congestion of vendors, visitors, and pedestrians etc.). There is not a rally fee for this rally and there is no camping fee in exchange for volunteering at the festival!! As always, we need volunteers to help with parking and utilities, setting up our installation dinner, preparing for the festival on Friday, and serving as docents in the restored homes or buildings during the festival on Saturday and Sunday.

Happy Hour is every afternoon at 4 PM. Please bring extra snacks to share and your own beverages in a non-alcoholic container, like your favorite cup. During Happy Hour on Thursday, we will finalize the volunteer teams and where you be docents during the festival for half-days on Saturday and Sunday. We will have sign-up sheets for that, along with sheets the Fort Christmas Historical Society sent to me for house sitting and such. When your team is not volunteering, they can tour the festival, take a tram tour at the nearby Orlando Wetlands, or hike at Tosohatchee Wildlife Management Area.

The Annual Officer Installation Dinner will be at 6 PM on Thursday night and is catered by Bernie's Gourmet-to-go in Oviedo, Florida. They will have a tray of chicken marsala, a tray of vegetarian lasagna, and a large bowl of salad. We will also be having our usual cake for dessert and lemonade or tea to drink. Cracker Christmas & Installation of Officers — Part I 12/5 to 12/9



This is a <u>semi-boon-docking</u> camping experience. They have a few 30A outlets that we <u>split be-</u> <u>tween everyone</u>. You should bring at least **50 feet of extension cord and be able to step down to a 20 amp Edison plug**. You will probably get only 7 or 8A or so as we split 30, 4 ways. This will be enough to charge your batteries and run small things, however, you'll want to use propane for your heat and water heater. Blow dryers, microwaves, and electric coffee makers usually blow the circuits. You can also park in a sunny spot to take advantage of your solar or in a remote spot to take advantage of your generator. Just let us know when you're parking.

We will have shared water, so in addition to your normal water set up, **bring one long hose and a Yconnector**. I usually just fill my tanks with the hose and then use my water pump so I have better pressure. We will not be able to dump our tanks on site, but they have a restroom to help the tank situation. This is not usually a problem, as we are able to stretch 4 to 5 days with our tanks if we have an additional restroom to use. A dump station is available at a nearby RV park for a small fee. Friends with dogs: their official policy at the park is "no dogs". However, we've always had our friendly pooches there, but we walk them very discreetly in the early mornings, lunch time, and late evenings and we <u>always</u> pick up after them. They tend to look the other way for us if we're in stealth mode, so we can't really flaunt it, especially in front of the guests, since they're not allowed to have dogs in the park.

As always, there will be fun things to do during the non-work times and evenings including campfires, sing or play-along time, games, hikes, bike rides, birding, photo opportunities, sunrises, sunsets, stargazing, and more! The final itinerary will be emailed to those who registered. Can't wait to see you there!! Please reach out to me for any questions.



Devil's Den Spring in Williston, Florida. March 31 to April 7, 2025

We are planning a week-long buddy rally starting March 31-April 7 at Devil's Den in Williston, Florida. Located on the edge of Levy County, Marion County and nearby Alachua, there is a multitude of activities, from Cedar Key to Rainbow Springs and Paynes Prairie.

We recently spent a weekend snorkeling in the karst cavern and felt like a weekend was just not enough. Cedar Lake Woods and Gardens is next door, and if you enjoy gardens this is not to be missed. Another day might be spent at the most beautiful Kanapaha Botanical Gardens in Gainesville. A visit to the University of Florida Natural History Museum is a must where you can see a fully intact fossil skeleton of a Tremarco's Floridanus, an extinct species of bear dating back 10,000 years geological evidence which dates Devil's Den to be between 10,000 and 75,000 years old. Hiking Paynes Prairie, Devil's Millhopper, Sweetwater Wetlands Park are some of the other activities we will be planning. Ichetucknee and Santa Fe Rivers are also nearby, with the Springs Institute in High Springs a worthy visit.

To lock into the weekly rate of \$225.00, book online soon because it is first come first serve and they will hold that rate until this year's end. When registering, be sure to put AIRSTREAM CLUB in the space that reads company name. There are 32 sites. We are looking for some co-hosts, love to have new club members that have not hosted before, to step up to lead an activity or host a meal.
