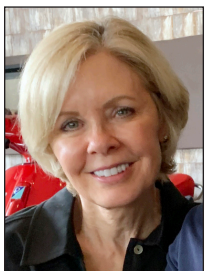
Editors' Corner

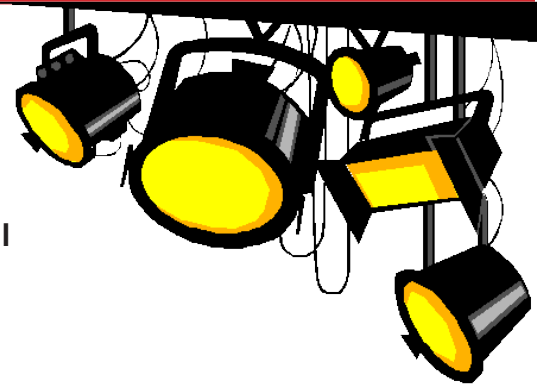

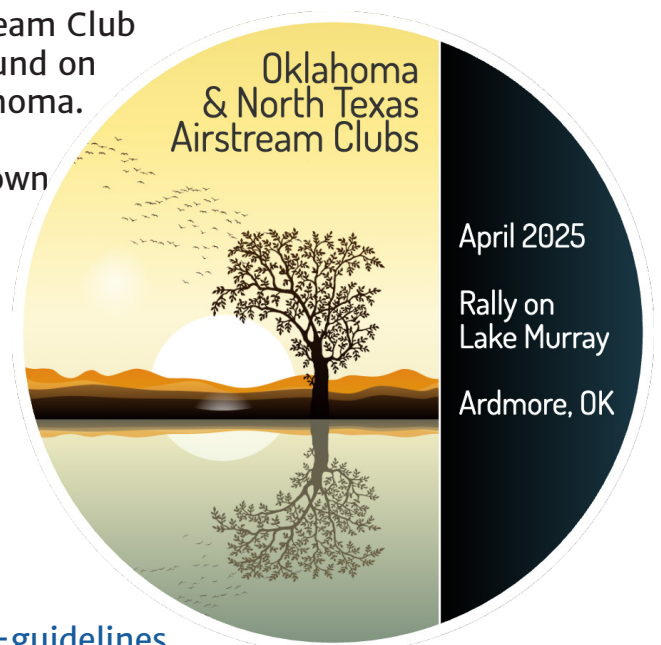

Editor David's Airstream Club Primer

November 2024: Let's Talk Cats!

This month's column is a little bit of a departure since it doesn't strictly deal with the ins-and-outs of the Airstream Club. It could apply to any RV traveler. Nevertheless, I was struggling for a topic until my co-editor, and fellow cat lover, suggested I write about Airstreaming cats. So, here we go.

I don't think I've mentioned it in this column before, but Kim and I travel with 3 cats (little known fact: Kim and my cousin call me the Crazy Cat Lady). Cats are sometimes given short shrift in discussions about traveling pets because they often remain unseen. Certainly, there are those who harness them up and take them for walks around the campground, and some even let them wander off-leash. But, unless you are lucky enough to catch their owners loading them into or out of the Airstream, you may not notice them staring at you from a window.

Let's start with some commonly asked questions. (CAQ. FAQs are so passé!)

- Where do you put the litterbox? How many do you have? (Why do RVers always turn to questions about waste first?)

Ours goes under the dinette. Rule of thumb for the home is 1 box per cat, plus 1 extra. Those numbers don't add up in a trailer. It's scooped multiple times per day, sometimes after each use. I scoop into a family-sized peanut M&M's container which has a wide mouth and a screw-on lid. When that's full—it goes into a grocery sack, then to the trash. Our cats love to play the Oooh, Clean Litterbox! game whereby they watch me scoop the latest business before taking their turn. We also carry a small one behind the passenger seat in the truck. I think they've used it twice in 3 years and 25,000 miles.

- Do they ride in the truck or the trailer? (Not applicable to Land Yacht owners.)

Truck. In my opinion, no living thing outside of a plant should ride in the trailer.

- Do they like traveling? Have they adjusted over time?

Mario, our 9-year old, HATED the truck when we would take him for rides in preparation for this lifestyle. He even tried crapping us into submission. Now he tolerates it, but only because he shares his back seat carrier with his teddy bear, Stitch, one of our 3-year old brothers. Milo, the other brother, rides in his own carrier. The 2 of them like to come out (1 at a time) while we're driving; Mario just wants it to be over. Stitch and Milo sometimes get sick on roller coaster roads.

- What about scratching?

Do you know a good upholsterer? It's lucky we love our 30-foot Classic because if we ever decided to sell, we'd either have to drop some dough on the interior or let it go "as is." We do keep cardboard scratchers about, and I use carpet-like stair treads on some surfaces, both of which they use. Some cat owners don't have a problem. Lucky them.

- Aren't you afraid they'll get out?

We keep our cats indoors all the time—at home and away. We don't want them to develop a taste for outside. They are very happy in the Airstream—eating, sleeping, cuddling, tearing up and down the aisle, watching people and wildlife from the panoramic windows. Sometimes we put suction-cup bird feeders on the windows when we're parked for extended stays. What fun those are!

- Where can I learn more?
