## **Message from President Jon Schwenke**

Fellow CIAC Airstreamers.

Happy Fall. The Fall colors around us this year are just awesome and very vibrant. Those of us that attended the Relax/Unwind Rally at Patoka Lake were able to enjoy the cool nights and pleasant days of the Fall Season. The Solo Fire Pit was a favorite spot to share a conversation.

Prior to this Rally many of us enjoyed the International Rally in Sedalia, MO. Just shy of 1,300 Airstreams attended with many having to bow



out due to the horrendous hurricanes in the Southeast. We collectively did Airstream proud with major financial contributions being made to support the room remodeling of the local Bothwell Hospital, local support of those in need of healthcare, contributions to the hurricane disaster fund, and major donations from the Airstream Foundation in support of local causes. Where Airstream goes, we leave a very meaningful lasting imprint that is joyously received. On the fun side the highlight of the International Rally had to be the epic Halloween Costume Party and Dance sponsored by the Vintage Airstream Club. It was enjoyed to the last DJ tune.

We were able to hold our Annual Business Meeting. Major announcements out of that meeting were that our new slate of Officers and Trustees were voted in to guide our club beginning January 1, 2025. We had 25 Airstream BRN voting with 35 individual votes cast. All candidates were elected to serve with a unanimous vote. Also, from the floor a candidate for 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President in the person of Barry Boyer was nominated to serve in this position. It was moved, seconded, and voted on to name Barry Boyer for this position. As a Club we now have a full slate of candidates for all positions. Those candidates will be installed at the Holiday Joint Party on December 7<sup>th</sup> or at an upcoming Rally in 2025.

To stay ahead of raising operational costs and per our constitution, your Officers and Trustees voted on and approved a raise in Club Membership Fees from the current \$15 to a new \$20 annual fee. This will go into effect on November 1st, 2024.

Finally, I have the new CIAC "Heart of Indiana" Flag in my possession. They turned out great. We ordered 12 flags, and I have received commitments from 7 owners to purchase a flag. If you have previously ordered a flag I will communicate with you individually. If you would like a new flag to proudly fly the CIAC Banner, please let me know and I will get one to you. Price per flag is \$83.35 plus shipping.

Lastly, please join us for the Joint Holiday Party in Brown County on December 7<sup>th</sup>. The details are in the flyer enclosed. It is a great time to share the Holiday spirit with our friends from the Indiana Airstream Club as well as your fellow Club Members.

## Recipe Round Up ~

## **Campfire Apple Crisp**

Similar to a Campfire Hobo Dinner Packets, this campfire apple crisp is a simple foil packet recipe. Just assemble your ingredients together, set it, and forget it! Delicious and quick, this apple crisp is a great option if you want something sweet, but not a s'more. Though honestly, can you ever have too many s'mores?

Prep: 10 Min Cook: 15 Min Serving: 1

## **Ingredients:**

- 1/4 cup oatmeal
- 1 tbsp. flour
- 3 tbsp. packed brown sugar
- 1 tbsp. cinnamon
- 2 tbsp. butter
- 1 diced apple

Optional: whipped cream, or ice cream for serving



1. Prepare the Crumb Topping:

Combine oatmeal, flour, brown sugar, cinnamon, and 1 tbsp of butter in separate container. It's best to use your hands to work the butter into the dry ingredients but if can also use a fork to combine them.

2. Prepare Your Packet:

Grease the bottom of your foil packet with your remaining tablespoon of butter. Place your diced apples in the foil, and sprinkle over the crumb topping. Set over a cooking grate, or near hot coals for 15 minutes, and enjoy!



## 2025 Region 5 Rally A Racing Good Time!

ACI Region 5 announces the opening of sign-ups for our 2025 Region Rally to be held in Indianapolis, Indiana from May 8th to May 14, 2025. (6 days!)

This Rally will highlight much of the best that Indianapolis has to offer, including a day of racing at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway for the IndyCar Sonsio Grand Prix, visits to downtown Indianapolis and the town of Speedway, fun themed dinners and much more.

Our Rally Site will be the beautiful Fitness Farm located 10 minutes from downtown Indianapolis on West 44th Street in the Wynnedale neighborhood. Here's the link to the Fitness Farm: <a href="http://fitnessfarm.org/">http://fitnessfarm.org/</a>

## Rally Pricing: There will be two pricing options for camping at The Fitness Farm.

- $\Rightarrow$  \$315 including 30-amp generator power for 1 rig and 1 person.
- $\Rightarrow$  \$215 for boundocking (personal generators ok) for 1 rig with 1 person.
- $\Rightarrow$  \$35 for each additional person.
- $\Rightarrow$  \$35 for children 6 to 17 years old, under 5 years old are free.

Water and sewer hookups are not available. Bring your freshwater tank full and your holding tanks empty! 30-amp power will be supplied by a commercial generator.

Potable water and black tank pump outs will be available. There will be a charge for pump outs – pricing being negotiated now.

Because only 44 electric sites and 56 boondocking sites will be available, these sites are being offered to Region 5 members first until <u>November 17, 2024</u>. After that date, Rally sites will be offered to other ACI members. Please register as soon as you can!

We will keep a waiting list for both electric and boondocking sites if your choice is not available.
