

Stunning Fort Robinson State Park comprises more than 22,000 acres of exquisite Pine Ridge scenery, compelling Old West history, scenic camping and the park's own bison and Longhorn herds. Fort Robinson was operating as a military fort from the early days of the old west until after WWII. Many historical events occurred at the Fort, including the tragic Cheyenne Breakout in 1879 and the death of the famous Sioux Chief, Crazy Horse.

Over the years, the Fort served as Red Cloud Indian agency, Calvary remount station, K-9

training center and a POW camp. It became a State Park in 1962. Camping will be in the full hook up Red Cloud campground. Scheduled group events will include: Steak dinner cookout, A play at Post Playhouse repertory theater, Bike ride to nearby town of Crawford for ice cream. Other activity possibilities include: Jeep rides, horseback riding, many hiking trails, golf, and historical tours.

An easy day hike along Wildcat trail plus a day tour to Upper Antelope canyon and Horseshoe Bend in Page, AZ, and a guided tour into the Valley with a native tour guide are planned. A welcome dinner at the Stagecoach Cafe and a final dinner at the View restaurant are planned. John Wayne's cabin and trading post museum are nearby. On the way to Monument Valley there is a very scenic road, about 15 miles round trip, which is called Valley of the Gods, and 35 miles from Monument Valley, well worth the visit.
