If you want to try out fly fishing for the first time, you can without any investment in equipment or experience. His guides are great teachers.

Hare's Ear Fly Fishing will organize the float trips on the rivers of Tennessee. John Contis can do as many drift boats as we need. Make your reservations with him directly. Make sure he knows you are with the Indie Streamers Rally. The full-day Guided Float trips include all equipment, flies, non-alcoholic drinks, and lunch.

Guided Float trips on the South Holston River, Watauga River, or Nolochucky River*. A block of guide times will be reserved until 2/15/2025 for the 19th, 20th, and 21st. **Two anglers per drift boat. \$600/ Boat full day.** Check with John Contis about the availability of guided trips before or after the rally on other rivers in the area.

Guided Wade trips are available for many other rivers in the area. Prices vary according to half or full day. The full-day Wade Trips include all equipment, flies, non-alcoholic drinks, and lunch. Half-day Wade Trips include all equipment, flies, and non-alcoholic drinks. Check with John Contis about the conditions and availability during our week, or before or after the rally.

*Nolochucky may be fishable by May but was damaged in the floods of Hurricane Helene.

Wade Trips can be solo/non-guided. Locations and suggestions for solo fishing areas can be requested as the season predictions become available.

Sharri has one drift boat reserved for May 19th-21. So if someone is a single angler you could share the boat with her.

Event Details

Asheville, NC is only 1 hour and 15 minutes from the campsite with world-class restaurants, an arts district, and great shopping. The Biltmore Hotel in Ashville has reopened after Hurricane Helene. Please note that reservations are required for entry to Biltmore House. It's recommended to purchase tickets in advance to secure your preferred date and time.

Additional Information for Anglers:

The South Holston River, or SoHo as locals call it, is one of the best blue-ribbon trout streams in the nation. Anglers come from all over the United States to access this famous tailwater. Mighty headshakes, dogged dives toward cover, and acrobatic leaps make bass one of the most exciting freshwater fish to catch on the fly. Add the flexible light action of a fly rod to the equation, and the excitement increases exponentially. Sometimes fly fishing can also be more productive than fishing other lures or baits.

The Watauga River is located in eastern Tennessee, and the Cherokee name for it is said to mean "river of plenty". It is a great place to fish for trout because of its many different types of water, year-round fishing, and a variety of habitats:

- Variety of water types: The river has fast water, deep pools, and grassy banks, which
 provide different habitats for trout.
- Year-round fishing: The tailwater section of the river, below Wilbur Dam, has stable water temperatures and is good for fishing all year.
- Trout species: The river is home to brown trout, rainbow trout, and brook trout.
- Fly fishing: The river is a good place to practice casting and mending skills, and you can use dry flies, nymphs, and streamers.
- Wildlife: The river is home to a variety of wildlife, including aquatic insects.
- Scenic setting: The river is surrounded by bluffs and farms, and the lower slopes of the bluffs have wildflowers and ferns.
- Access: There are several public access points for wading and boating.

The Great Smoky Mountains National Park is known for its wild trout, including rainbow, brook, and brown trout. For the best wading fishing experience, head to Abrams Creek, a tributary of the Little Tennessee River. The creek is known for its large brown trout, which can be found in the deeper pools.

And in South Carolina for trout and bass, you can fish the Chattooga River, Chauga River, Middle Saluda River, Eastatoee River, and Matthews Creek. Greenville's Downtown District is known for its music, the arts, restaurants, and shopping.
