Gil and Shanna Moll, BRN 01318 (*Affiliate Members*)

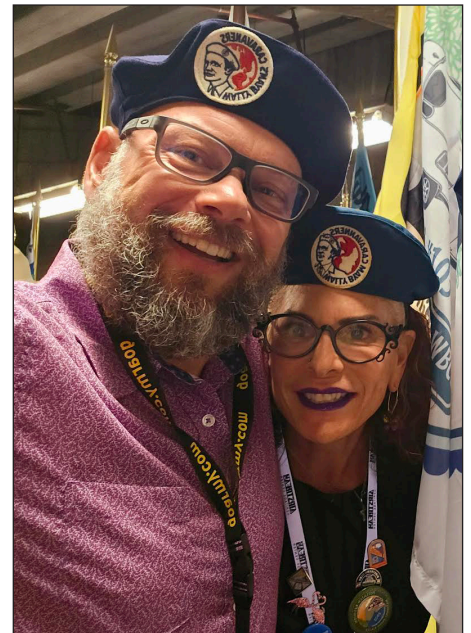
My name is Gil and my wife is Shanna. She's the current, albeit outgoing, president for TGPU (Texas Gulf Coast Unit).

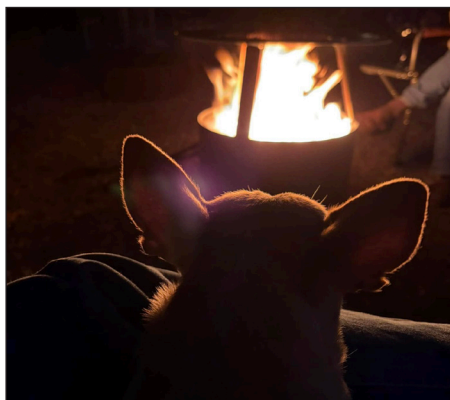

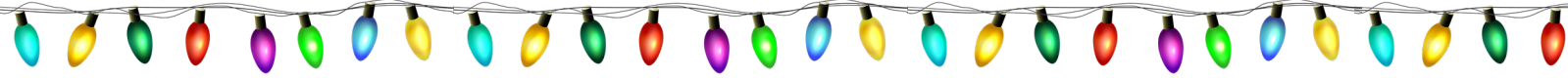

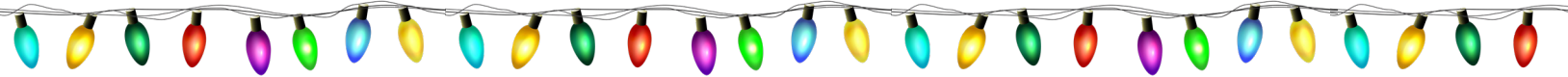
