We are located 300 yards south of US 378 on Holley Ferry Rd, 15 miles west of Lexington and 16 miles east of Saluda on the Lexington/Saluda County line.

If you want to bring your Airstream, please do so. We would love to have you. We have plenty of room. Feel free to come in before the 7th if you'd like. Bring your wye "Y" adapter (20-30 amp/household outlet adapter) and we will provide water.

We also have a dump station on site.

<u>ALL RVs PLEASE NOTE</u>: Enter the driveway at 2950 Holley Ferry Rd. This is a wider, flatter driveway installed many years ago to prevent dragging your trailer bumper. Just follow this driveway past the barn to the top of the hill up to our house.

Friday Afternoon: Spend the afternoon lounging around the pool deck. Supper at Shealy's BBQ in Leesville (9 miles away). Return to the farm for stargazing, games and social time.

Saturday Morning: Breakfast on your own or we recommend Southern Thymes Café across the road about ¼ mile. Then we can spend time catching up with friends.

<u>The luncheon will be on Saturday, December 7th from Noon – 2:00 pm, 2912 Holley Ferry Road</u> Bring a covered dish for the potluck. Various drinks will be provided by the Puryears.

Saturday Night: After lunch if time and weather permits, we can visit some antique shops. Supper on your own or we can check out another local favorite. 

For the past 30 years, Turpentine Creek has rescued over five hundred animals from private owners, roadside zoos, and situations of abuse and neglect. The residents of the sanctuary, primarily "Big Cats" with an emphasis on tigers, lions, leopards, and cougars, are provided with a lifelong home and care, including both physical and mental rehabilitation. Open air tram tours of the grounds are available and are led by one of TCWR's education or animal care team members. It is a wonderful opportunity to see and learn about the amazing animals that call the refuge their home. You can also wander through the self-guided Discovery Area where you can learn even more about TCWR's efforts to end the exotic animal trade.

Located just 20 minutes from Eureka Springs, AR and 1 ½ hours from Branson, MO, the refuge's six RV spots, all with electric and water

hookups are literally right next to the animals' habitats. It is definitely a different and memorable RV experience when your neighbor is a magnificent white tiger!

Wild Rice, Squash, Pomegranate

Ingredients:

2 cups wild rice, rinsed

4 oz. kale, ribs removed & chopped small (preferably the Tuscan variety, about ½ bunch or 2 cups)

¾ cup chopped green onion (from 1 large or 2 medium bunches), divided

4 oz. goat cheese (about ¾ cup crumbled)

Arils from 1 medium pomegranate, or ½ cup chopped dried cranberries

½ cup raw pepitas (green pumpkin seeds)

1 teaspoon extra-virgin olive oil

¼ teaspoon fine sea salt

¼ teaspoon ground cinnamon

Roasted Butternut Squash

1 small-to-medium (2 to 2 ½ pounds) butternut squash, cut into ¾-inch cubes

1 ½ tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil

¼ teaspoon fine sea salt

Ginger Dressing

¼ cup extra-virgin olive oil

2 tablespoons apple cider vinegar

1 tablespoon Dijon mustard

1 tablespoon maple syrup

1 tablespoon grated fresh ginger

¾ teaspoon fine sea salt



Instructions:

- Preheat the oven to 425 degrees F & line a large, rimmed baking sheet with parchment paper for easy clean-up, if desired.
- 2. Cooking the wild rice: Bring a large pot of water to boil. Add the rinsed rice & continue cooking, reducing heat as necessary to maintain a lively simmer, for 40 minutes to 55 minutes. It's done when the rice is pleasantly tender but still offers a light resistance to the bite. Remove from heat, drain the rice & return rice to the pot.
- 3. Meanwhile, roast the butternut: Place cubed butternut squash on your rimmed baking sheet. Drizzle it with olive oil & sprinkle with salt. Toss until the cubes are lightly & evenly coated in oil. Arrange them in a single layer & roast for 35 to 50 minutes, tossing after 20 minutes, until they are starting to turn golden on the edges & tender when pierced with a fork.
- While the wild rice & butternut cook, prepare all the remaining ingredients. Chop the kale & 4. green onion, remove the arils from the pomegranate, & whisk together all the dressing ingredients in a small bowl.
- 5. To toast the pepitas, combine the pepitas, 1 tsp. olive oil, ¼ tsp. each salt & cinnamon in a small skillet. Stir to combine & cook over medium heat until the pepitas are starting to turn golden on the edges & making little popping noises, about 3 to 5 minutes. Remove the skillet from the heat & set aside.
- 6. When the wild rice is finished cooking & still warm, stir in the kale, half of the green onions, & all the ginger dressing. Spread the mixture over a large serving platter or large serving bowl.
- 7. Arrange the butternut squash over the wild rice mixture. Crumble the goat cheese on top with a fork. Top with pomegranate arils, toasted pepitas, & remaining green onions. Serve.
