Registration

Rally registration will take place online via the Oregon Airstream Club website starting in January. Members will be emailed in advance with date and time details on when 2025 rally general registrations will open.

A 3-day registration process will be used.

- Day-1: hosts/co-hosts will register for their own rallies
- Day-2: hosts/co-hosts will register for a “thank you” rally
- Day-3: general registration begins

Complete registration schedules and instructions will be sent by email several days in advance.

To register online go to:

- Scroll down and click on orange “Oregon Airstream Club Events” button
- Rallies will be displayed in date order
- Click on any rally to view event web page
- When registration is open a “Register Online Here” button will appear
- Complete the online registration form including type of payment. You’ll have the option to pay by credit card (via PayPal) or by check.

PayPal is the preferred payment method. A PayPal account is not required. If you pay for your registrations by check, please mail it directly to the OAC treasurer (Stacey Rovinelli, 13606 NW 42nd Ave, Vancouver, WA, 98685), not the rally host. After you register online, you will be able to pay for multiple rallies with one check.

Enclose a note with your check detailing your rally registrations.

We will have a few rallies that will be confirmed and booked after the printed version of the rally handbook is distributed. These rallies will be added to the online version of the Rally Handbook and to the website for registration. The same three-day rally registration process will be used. Members will be emailed in advance with date and time details on when these additional rally registrations will open.

Some rallies are very popular and fill quickly so don’t delay. If the rally you want is full, immediately contact the host and ask to be placed on the waitlist. Very often people on the waitlist secure spots as cancellations occur, so don’t be discouraged. We have provided the phone number and email of each rally host. Also, feel free to reach out to them with questions or concerns regarding their rally.

Cancellation Policy

We get it, life happens, and things come up. For simplicity, here is the OAC rally cancellation policy.

If you cancel your registration for a rally site for any reason and your cancellation causes the OAC to incur any cost (full or partial), you will be responsible for paying that cost.

If you cancel your registration for a group camp (GC) rally, you will not receive a refund unless someone takes your spot from the host's waitlist. These group camp type rallies are clearly noted in the rally handbook and on the registration page with a "GC" included in the rally name.

All refunds are subject to rally venue cancellation policies, associated administrative fees, and a \$5 OAC cancellation fee. These costs will not exceed your initial payment amount. Our treasurer will be in contact with you regarding any refund.

Each rally host knows the specific cancellation policy for each rally venue, and they will coordinate with our rally coordinator and treasurer to assist you in the event you need to cancel.

If you need to cancel, please do so as soon as possible so the rally host can work with those on the waitlist to fill your spot. **Please don't give your rally spot to someone else on your own, as there are other members on the waitlist with priority for registering for that rally and the rally host will coordinate.**

Meals and Food

We've learned a lot having lived through a global pandemic. How we approach meals and food at rallies

has changed as a result. **Hosted meals are completely optional.**

The type and number of meals, if any, to be made available is decided by the rally host. Each host will decide on meals and prices for their meals. **Meal costs are not included in your rally registration fees.** Most often, hosts decide any rally meal plan closer to the rally date and you will hear from them directly with that information.

Participation in meals is completely optional and any meal cost will be defined by the rally host. If you participate in any meals offered by your host, you will need to pay your host directly while at the rally.
