The Finger Lakes of New York has one of the richest concentrations of wineries in the country. Our campground is located within a 15-minute drive of a dozen of the more than 60 wineries surrounding Seneca Lake. In addition, Finger Lakes Distilling and Grist Iron Brewing are but two of many opportunities to explore the beverage scene in this area. Watkins Glen is known as "The Heart of the Finger Lakes" with gorgeous parks and a historic downtown at the southern tip of Seneca Lake. The area offers the abundant natural beauty of Watkins Glen State Park, Sugar Hill State Forest, and Finger Lakes National Forest. An added bonus for your free day is the annual Naples Grape Festival on Saturday and Sunday.

The \$350 per person rally fee includes:

Members who cancel after being registered for any event will forfeit any third-party nonrefundable fees incurred by Grapes & Grains (G&G) or the event sponsor including but not limited to reservation fees, processing fees, site cancellation fees, prepaid excursion, tour, entertainment, and event fees. Any member/registrant who cancels within 30 days of the Rally start date will forfeit any prepaid rally fees and depending on the venue, potential RV site fees. Regardless of the reason or cause, if the timeliness of cancellation of your attendance does not allow G&G or its Host(s) to find replacement attendees or obtain refunds from any of the vendors or providers, a refund will not be made, and forfeiture of those costs will be incurred by the canceling member.

If Grapes & Grains should cancel a rally or event, all fees paid by any member/registrant will be refunded.

This Grapes & Grains refund policy is premised on the concept that the Intra-Club should neither profit from nor subsidize the cost of any member or registrant who cancels after registering for a G&G sponsored or hosted rally or event. We understand that circumstances arise where a

cancellation may be necessary, and every effort will be made to minimize the financial impact on both the Intra-Club and the member/registrant.

Any member/registrant who does not agree with a refund decision made by the organizers of a G&G sponsored event may appeal that decision to the G&G Executive Board by filing a written appeal request, including the reasons for a reversal of the refund decision, within 30 days of the original refund decision.
