Book your spot for the Croton Point & Pleasantville Music Festival Rally. Croton Point Park is a 508-acre park, the largest peninsula on the east shore of the Hudson River. Arrive Friday, stay to Monday if you desire. Twenty sites are being held for Watchung AC until February 28th.

If you wish, nearby on Saturday the 19th Annual Pleasantville Music Festival goes from 1:30 to 9:00 PM. Shop for crafts, feast from the food trucks, quench your thirst in the beer garden and of course enjoy the live music.

Sunday, take a leisure day to enjoy the scenic views of the Hudson River. You can paddle out renting a kayak, stand-up paddleboard or a Hobie pedalboard from the campground. Visit the Croton Point Nature Center housing exhibits on local flora, fauna and Native American history. Hike, bike & relax. Sit by the scenic river beach, toe or more in the water.

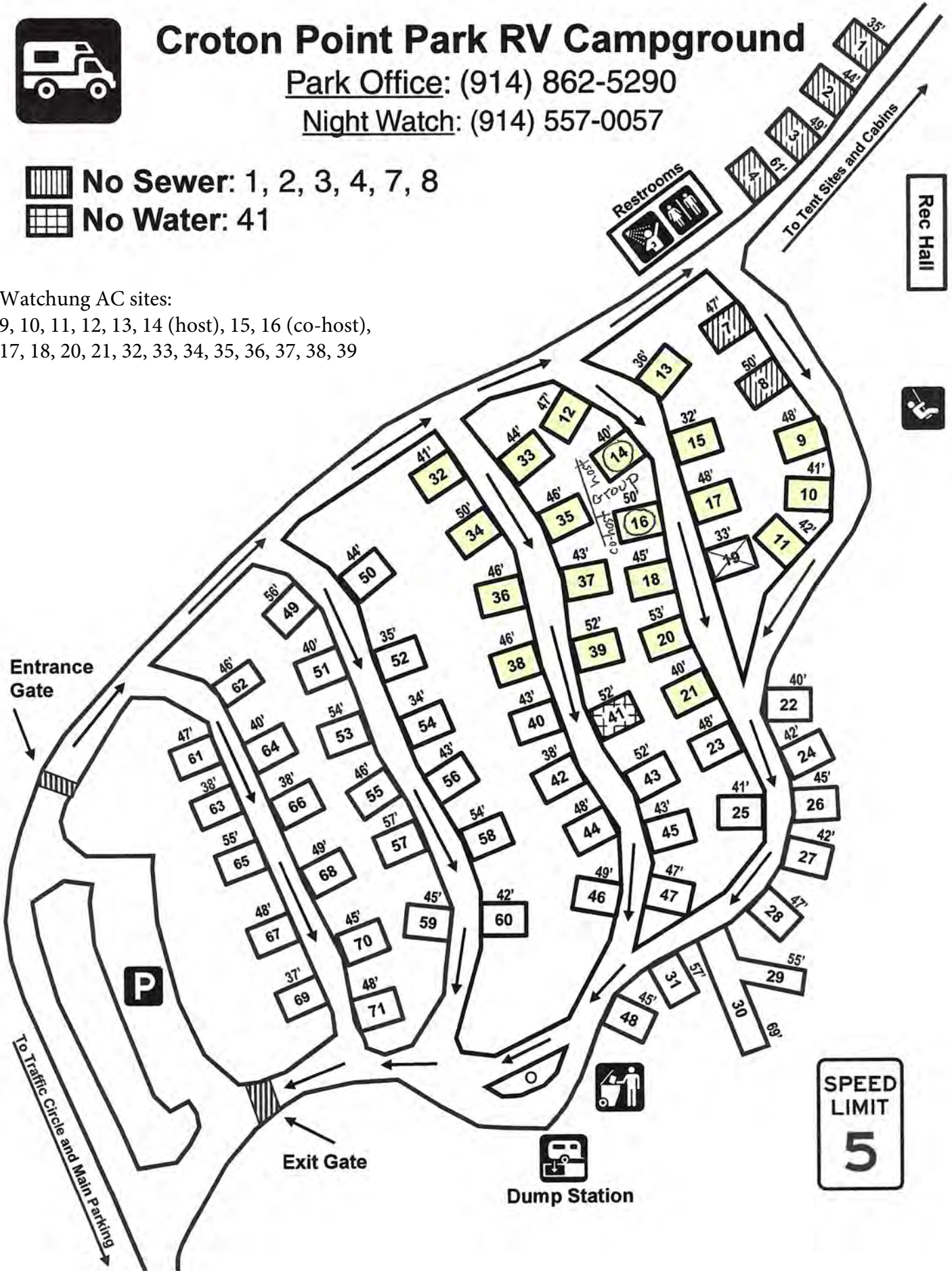

Croton Point Park RV Campground Rules and Regulations

- Campers may check in from 2 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. on the first day of reservation. If arriving after office hours call the night watchman at 914-557-0057.
- Campers must sign off on the rules upon arrival at campground.
- Upon arrival, campers must provide the park office with a list all other occupants of the RV site (six person maximum, including children).
- Permit holder must be 21 years of age or older and must remain on site overnight.
- No camping tents are allowed in the RV section of the campground.
- Campers are not allowed outside of the campground after dark. Campers may drive through the park to enter and exit the campground.
- No hard liquor may be consumed in the park. Only consumption of wine and beer is permitted.
- Permit holder will be responsible for any damages in their site or to park property.
- There is a maximum of two vehicles per site; overflow parking available for one additional car outside of campground.
- No commercial vehicles are allowed to be parked in the campground or anywhere in the park.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times.
- A maximum of two dogs are permitted at each site.
- Dogs are NOT allowed on the beach at any time.
- Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. daily.
- Garbage must be bagged and placed in the nearest dumpster
- Site must be left clean and litter free upon departure.
- Campers must vacate their campsite no later than 11 a.m. on the final day of their reservation.
- The gate card(s) received upon arrival must be returned at the end of your stay in person or in the drop box at the office. Failure to return the card will result in a \$50 fee for each card.
- All food items must be stored inside your vehicle to keep away animals.
- No pools are allowed in any campsite.
- Cats are not allowed in the campground.
- RV camping permits will be issued for no more than 90 days in a calendar year per household or vehicle.
- RV campers can have a maximum of six daily visitors; visitors may NOT stay overnight and must leave the park by 9 p.m.
- Daily visitors must check in at the park office.
- Daily parking fees apply to ALL visitors.
- No personal mail can be received at the park.
- No ground fires are permitted in the RV campground. Campers must provide their own raised fire pit if they intend on having a fire.

- Campers get free access to the beach during their stay; wristbands must be obtained at the park office.

Violation of any campground rule is grounds for eviction. Anyone who is evicted is not entitled to a refund.

There is no guarantee of camping spots. Westchester County Parks reserves the right to change and modify reservations at any time.

Cancellations

Any cancellation made at least 30 days prior to the reservation arrival date will result in a full refund. Any cancellation made less than 30 days, but at least seven days (one week) prior to the reservation arrival date will be entitled to a credit for a future stay, minus a \$50 cancellation fee. Any cancellation made less than seven days prior to the reservation arrival date shall receive no refund or credit. There is no refund for early departures. Camping is an outdoor experience therefore, we do not give refunds or credits for weather or natural conditions.

Bathrooms

Our campground bathrooms will be winterized from Mid October-Mid April (weather pending) - only portable toilets will be available during those times.

Westchester County - Fire Wood Policy

The Westchester County Department of Parks, Recreation & Conservation must comply with Article 14, Section 167, part 139 of the NY State Agricultural and Markets Law concerning the use of firewood at all our facilities. The intent of these rules and regulations is to control the spread of dangerous tree insects and diseases.

Effective immediately, wood of any size or type may not be brought into County Parklands unless it is certified "Kiln-Dried" and secured within original wrapping from the distributor or purchased from a PRC facility.

Any camper or visitor at any PRC facility with un-certified firewood will either leave it at the main office for disposal or will be required to immediately leave the facility. Visitors or campers in violation of this policy will forfeit their campsite and be asked to leave without a refund.

Croton Point Park firewood will be offered for sale at a rate of \$12 per bundle.
