Things to do nearby:

- **Ft. Richardson Historic Site** established in 1860, protecting settlers along the Texas frontier. Several original buildings still stand today at what was once the largest US Army installation. Self-guided and Ranger-led tours are available.
- The Lost Creek Reservoir Trailway winds along scenic Lost Creek and the shores of 2 lakes. Both lakes are available for fishing without a fishing license, and they are stocked with bass and catfish.
- Jacksboro historic Town Square centered around the beautiful Jack County Courthouse, offers vintage storefronts, shops and cafés. Many of these buildings were built over a century ago. And right down Main Street from the square you don't want to miss Herd's Hamburgers, originated in 1916, making smashburgers long before they became all the rage.
- Jack County Museum tells the story of Jack County from Native American artifacts to pioneer tools along with old photos and documents.
