


Club Store Merchandise

Upgrade

Truma AquaGo comfort – On-Demand Hot Water By Dave Gray

My Wife Donna and I purchased our first Airstream trailer, a 27' Globetrotter, in 2022. It came with a Girard tankless water heater which really didn't perform the way we wanted it to. Every time we took a shower it would take awhile for the water to warm up, and when we paused the flow at the Oxygenics shower head to lather up and then turned the water back on, the water would come out cold for about 30 seconds before warming up.

After a month of research, we decided to upgrade to the Truma AquaGo Comfort unit and we couldn't be happier. The Truma has about a 1 liter reservoir to store the heated water in. If you turn the water off during the shower (navy shower) to soap up, you get hot water when you turn the water back on. That wasn't the case with the Girard. You get a blast of warm at first (what was left in the water line) then cold water as the Girard fires back up to heat the water.

With the Truma AquaGo comfort, we enjoy hot water reliably around the clock for showering, hand washing, and dishes. And, at 60,000 BTU, the AquaGo instant water heater is the most powerful RV water heater on the market. It fits perfectly where the existing Girard was located with a few extra parts.

- AquaGo automatically adjusts temperature based on demand with microprocessor-controlled step-less burner management between 20,000 and 60,000 BTU

If you decide you want to do the upgrade, definitely shop around. Someone posted on the AS forums that they were quoted \$6000 from Airstream which is crazy. The best price I found locally in San Luis Obispo County was \$2620 which included parts and labor. We've had the opportunity to use our new water heater on numerous camping trips and Donna is soooo happy as she prefers to use the Airstream shower instead of the campground facilities. Hopefully in the future, Airstream will upgrade their water heaters to a Truma. **DG**
