The Rally

The rally will be held at Penn Wood Airstream Park in New Bethlehem, Pennsylvania. Arrive on Thursday, August 14th and depart on Monday, August 18th. We are just 4 hours from York, PA so an easy and beautiful drive to the International Rally.

There will be coffee and a continental breakfast each morning, a welcome dinner, a wine tasting at the campground with a large charcuterie table, fire pit

camaraderie, trivia and games (with prizes!) and one day will include a coach bus trip to Pittsburgh for a day of beer, cocktails and good times as we visit 3-5 different breweries, distilleries and craft cocktail bars (Rally fee covers bus ride, and some tastings but not all, lunch will be on your own). On your day off enjoy hiking amongst old growth hemlocks and/or visiting some of the local breweries in and around Clarion, PA.

The Rally Fee

The \$250 rally fee includes: arrival night Welcome Happy Hour and Dinner at beautiful Penn Wood Airstream Park, coffee and breakfast each morning in our Pavilion, bus Trip to Pittsburgh with 3 stops (coach bus and some tastings are included in rally fee, whatever you consume over the included items will be on your dime, lunch is on your own), wine tasting Happy Hour with large charcuterie spread at Penn Wood campground with souvenir glass for our farewell evening, nightly firepit, and a game night with prizes.

Grapes & Grains Refund Policy:

Members who cancel after being registered for any event will forfeit any third-party non-refundable fees incurred by Grapes & Grains (G&G) or the event sponsor including but not limited to reservation fees, processing fees, site cancellation fees, prepaid excursion, tour, entertainment, and event fees. Any member/registrant who cancels within 30 days of the rally start date will forfeit any prepaid rally fees and depending on the venue, potential RV site fees. Regardless of the reason or cause, if the timeliness of cancellation of your attendance does not allow G&G or it's host(s) to find replacement attendees or obtain refunds from any of the vendors or providers, a refund will not be made, and forfeiture of those costs will be incurred by the cancelling member.

If Grapes & Grains should cancel a rally or event, all fees paid by any member/registrant will be refunded.

This Grapes & Grains refund policy is premised on the concept that the Intra-Club should neither profit from nor subsidize the cost of any member or registrant who cancels after registering for a G&G sponsored or hosted rally or event. We understand that circumstances arise where a cancellation may be necessary, and every effort will be made to minimize the financial impact on both the Intra-Club and the member/registrant.

Any member/registrant who does not agree with a refund decision made by the organizers of a G&G sponsored event may appeal that decision to the G&G Executive Board by filing a written appeal request, including the reasons for a reversal of the refund decision, within 30 days of the original refund decision.
