
Greetings from the Presidential Aluminum Office

Greetings,

Let's start where we left off in the Jan/Feb newsletter..... What does it mean to rally? Webster's says the definition of a rally is, "to bring into order again; gather and organize or inspire anew". As I said last month.....What a perfect definition for our club rallies!! As promised, I am going to talk about duties of a rally host as well as some ideas on choosing rally sites and activities...

Rally hosts are just that, a host. Webster's dictionary defines host in 2 ways that pertain to our Airstream club.

- 1. a person who receives or entertains guests socially
- 2. a place or organization that provides facilities and services for an event or function

Hosting a rally is kind of like having a large party at a venue and arranging for all the catering and entertainment.

Obviously, there are some upfront things that need to be considered like date, location, cost, etc. When choosing a campground, it's always good to consider their facilities such as meeting space for meals, kitchen facilities, and of course "happy hour" gathering locations.

Other things to consider about locations are local attractions, shopping, wineries, museums, and bike or hiking trails. As a campground host, the local attractions or activities can become your theme for the rally and group excursions can be fashioned to include those attractions or activities.

Much like the large party, the host should ensure that all participants feel welcome. Happy hours are a great way to integrate new members or visitors from other clubs. An arrival meal planned by the host is also a good way to "break the ice" and set the tone for the rally. A departing breakfast (simple) is a club tradition and a good time for "See you down the road".



Embark on a mesmerizing journey into a floral wonderland as the Rocky Shoals Spider Lilies transform the Catawba River into a sea of delicate white blooms from mid-May to mid-June.

As a federally endangered species, these native wildflowers are a rare sight, thriving only in select rivers in the Southeast. Stretched along the Catawba River on the South Carolina fall line, Landsford Canal State Park is home to the world's largest population of Rocky Shoals Spider Lilies.



Stay updated on the bloom conditions with the park's "Lily Watch," a weekly online update providing insights into the current state of this captivating floral phenomenon.
