Collected tabs will be tallied by weight.

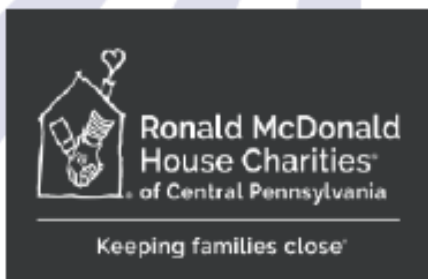
Did you know - a gallon size bag of pop tabs weighs roughly 2.5 lbs?

It has been 20 years since the last National Rally was held in Indianapolis, IN. Join Region 5 as we resurrect this rally celebrating the iconic Indianapolis Motor Speedway from May 8th to May 14th.

This Rally will highlight much of the best that Indianapolis has to offer, including a day of racing at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway for the IndyCar Sonsio Grand Prix, visits to downtown Indianapolis and the town of Speedway, fun themed dinners and much more.

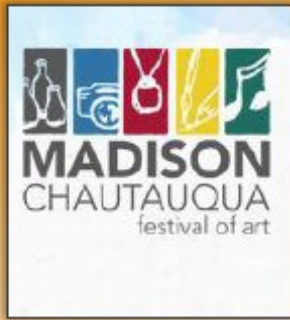
