Spring break this year found us at Chewacla State Park in Auburn, AL. Chewacla is a beautiful park located outside of Auburn, home of the Auburn Tigers, and just down the road from Historic Tuskegee. Cooler weather cut Thursday short for most, with some heading out for dinner and others retiring early into their campers. Friday was football day, and after breakfast we headed to Auburn University to tour Jordan-Hare Stadium.



Three Auburn marketing students led our tour and did a fantastic job! They were even very tolerant of our Gator, Crimson Tide and Nat'l Champion Ohio State Buckeye fans. We visited the Tiger Den, Media Room, Broadway Suite, Heisman Room, the Tiger Locker Room and were even able to stand alongside Pat Dye field. The tour was spectacular and Jordan-Hare Stadium is an exceptional facility. Can I get a War Eagle!! Friday evening's Taco Bar capped off a much warmer evening. Saturday was about fighters, and after breakfast we headed over

to the Tuskegee Airmen National Historic Site. The Tuskegee Airmen were determined young men who became America's first Black military aviators in the Army Air Corps (AAC), a precursor of the U.S. Air Force. They flew more than 15,000 sorties in Europe and North Africa during World War II, with great distinction! In addition to some 1,000 pilots, the Tuskegee program trained nearly 14,000 navigators, bombardiers, instructors, aircraft and engine



mechanics, control tower operators and other maintenance and support staff. The museum and grounds were an interesting history lesson in perseverance for everyone. Buc-ee's was the next stop for most, because who can pass up a Buc-ee's brisket sandwich and beaver nuggets? The afternoon found us napping, visiting and exploring the park's waterfall. Saturday night, David manned the grill and cooked up burgers for everyone. A special thanks again to Jason, our club barista, for hot and delicious coffee each morning. And welcome to our first timers, Elwood and Patricia McElhaney from Tallahassee, and Vicky Lawrence and Jay Roach from Panama City.

From the Historian's Desk... Don't go Color Blind!

Hey fellow Big Benders and Affiliates. After an incident occurred with fellow RV'ers at a local BP gas station, and seeing this mishap re-occur more than a few times, I felt it worth a quick word. About a year ago, a fellow camper pulled into the BP at I-10 and S/R 19, in Monticello, FL, for fuel and a bite to eat. The problem was that this gas station does not sell diesel, but all the fuel handles are green. Unfortunately the diesel tank got filled with gasoline, but thankfully the error was realized not long after. The driver did the right thing and shut the rig down immediately and had it towed to a diesel repair shop. The good news was that their quick action saved the engine. And after an unplanned delay, they were safely back on their way.

Since that incident I have witnessed on more than a few occasions, a repair vehicle pumping out the tanks of other campers, fifth wheels and a small delivery truck. I'm not sure why BP hasn't done something to warn of this hazard. So please be careful at all filling stations and make sure the correct fuel is being pumped. Green is not always diesel!

Big Bend has come into the digital world!

Members with Zelle accounts can pay rally fees directly to the Big Bend Florida Airstream Club through the club Zelle address, <u>club153@airstreamclub.org</u>. The treasurer can also quickly reimburse members with Zelle for rally expenses.

Of course, cash and checks will still be accepted!

Instructions to send and receive payments via Zelle - Big Bend FL Airstream Club

2,200 banks have Zelle capabilities, so check your bank's mobile banking app. The standalone Zelle mobile app no longer allows users to send and receive money transfers as of 4/4/2025. So if your bank supports it, set up your Zelle account through your bank. When setting up your account, please include an email address in your contact information as club funds will only be transferred to members via an email address.

To transfer funds to Big Bend, use the following address: club153@airstreamclub.org

When sending funds, please indicate what the payment is for on the memo line. If you are sending payment for multiple items, please also note the amount for each item.
