Here are a few things you need to know for the Rally:

Where: 5971 Hemingway Hwy, Nesmith, SC

On google maps this address will take you to the entrance of a dirt road to the Farm. Look for two orange cones on posts on either side of the entrance. There will also be a Club flag flying. When you enter make a wide turn! If you get lost call Carroll Burrows (843-319-6390), he knows all the back roads in Williamsburg County and can give you directions.

Parking: Proceed down the dirt road until see farm buildings and the road crosses a ditch, STOP. We will meet you and get you parked. It will be **"Rally Style Parking".** This means that you will be parking very close to the other trailers. How close depends on how many people register for the Rally. We will attempt to accommodate everyone that wants to attend.

Hook Ups: None! It will be dry camping (boondocking). So come with a full freshwater tank and your gray and blackwater tanks empty. Instructions for sterilizing your freshwater tank are in the notes you received at the New Owners Seminar in February. You will be able to drain gray water only on the ground and there will be a dump site as you leave the Rally on Sunday. Come with your batteries charged. You will be allowed to run Quiet Generators (like Honda generators). Please no loud industrial generators. We may have to establish generator hours, if noise is an issue. Fresh drinking water is available to fill your tank, but you may need a container to fill and empty it into your tank. Bring a flashlight because there are no streetlights on the farm.

Food: Meals provided by the club will be, Thursday Supper, Friday Supper, Saturday Breakfast, and Bring enough food with you for the other meals. There are no grocery stores close and due to our p be convenient to get your vehicle out. **There will be a rally fee to pay for the food but no camping**



Skeet Shooting: We will be asking you to reply on the jot form if you want to shoot, so we have a number. Bring your shotgun and a box of shells. Carroll Burrows has a thrower and will have clay pigeons. Bruce Melville will be our Rangemaster, so follow his instructions or
