These members had joined WBCCI (Wally Byam Caravan Club International) through the Texas Unit in San Marcos, Texas. The first President was Horace Barker. Many wonderful memories remain from those first days, where we nearly always had to go self-contained. We have shared losses and blessings in the first twenty-five years since our Unit was organized. Many of the members now reside full time at the North Texas Airstream Community in Hillsboro, Texas.





Co-Editor David's Travelogue

April 2025 : Preparations

Welcome back to my regular column. I hope you noticed the title change. Last month I took a little hiatus, partly because I was unusually busy, but partly because I was having difficulty coming up with new ideas for my Airstream Club Primer series. This month I'm going to try something new. On April 10, Kim and I set out on an Airstream adventure that will take us from Texas...to our niece's wedding in Southern California...to our friend's music conservatory in northern Idaho... to the International Rally in York, PA... to my brother's backyard in Mystic, CT...and back again. In between, there will be a plethora of yet-to-be-determined waypoints. We'll be gone for the better part of a year, so I hope you enjoy the format change. And I hope you learn about some new places you'd like to check out yourself.

But before we go anywhere, let's talk about preparations. In our first 3 years of retirement Airstreaming, we've been averaging about 6 out of every 12 months on the road, with our longest trip being 9 months in our very first year! You'd think we might deserve the title of seasoned travelers by now. But there's something about a full year that's daunting. A year encompasses 4 seasons, so you need to do some all-weather packing. And our Airstream was practically new when we started in 2022, so we need to be ready for more on-the-fly surprises. No, this is not just another, longer trip; it's the culmination of everything we've learned so far.

Fortunately, we had plenty of time to get ready. Kim, who's mostly responsible for keeping the inside of the trailer provisioned and organized (for us AND the cats) started by emptying it completely. She gave it a thorough cleaning (pulled out all the drawers and everything!) and evaluated what old stuff didn't need to go back in, and what new stuff we should have on hand this time around. I, on the other hand, am mostly responsible for making sure that nothing's broken and everything works. This was my late winter Mr. Fix-It list: replace popped rivets; clean the window screens; replace the malfunctioning inverter; replace a bad GFCI breaker; get new tires (for truck AND trailer); fix the trailer brakes (I discovered when I changed the tires they weren't working at all); prop up the sagging shower door; change the dripping shower valve; replace the shower

head and toilet flush valve (which both froze and split due to my not-diligent-enough winterizing job); bolster the back-of-the-refrigerator cooling capability; reaffix some loose cabinet trim; give the waste tanks a good flushing; tighten a bunch of screws; treat all the rubber gaskets with silicone spray (truck AND trailer); tune up the bicycle; unpack, sweep, and repack the truck bed, including a few new tools; and detail the inside of the truck. I never did get to washing the outside of our vehicles, so we're hitting the road dirty. I guess they both would have been windy-desert-dust-covered again by now anyway.Next month, I'll tell you about some stops on our route out of Texas and into New Mexico. Until then ... See you down the road!
