Last but not least we had a great turnout for the March rally with the Alabama group. We had a total of 22 rigs and 40 or more people. I am looking forward to the next joint rally!

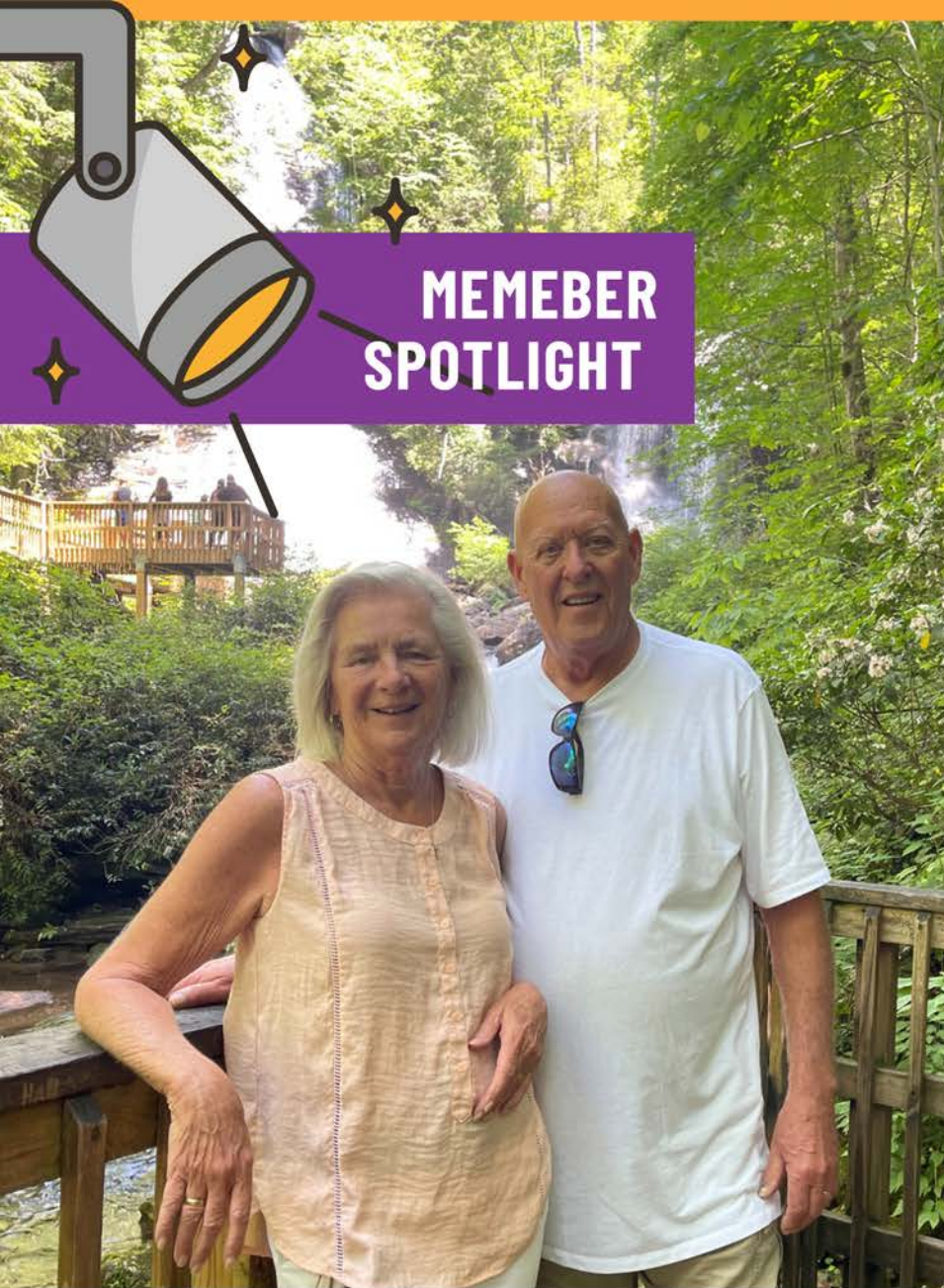

RECIPE

Vegetarian Chili For A Crowd

Servings – 24 | Prep Time – 10 minutes | Cook Time - 60 minutes

INGREDIENTS

8 tbsp extra virgin olive oil
4 cups carrots, chopped
4 cups red bell peppers, chopped
4 cups green bell pepper, chopped
4 cups onions, chopped
8 fresh garlic cloves, minced
4 fresh green chili peppers, seeded, finely chopped
4 tbsp ground ancho chili pepper
4 tbsp ground cumin
4 28-oz cans crushed tomatoes
4 16-oz cans pinto beans, rinsed and drained
4 16-oz cans cannellini beans, rinsed and drained
4 16-oz cans black beans, rinsed and drained
2 8-oz cans tomato paste
salt and pepper to taste

TOPPINGS

sour cream
fresh cilantro, chopped
fresh scallions, chopped
shredded cheese
salsa fresca
avocado, chopped

DIRECTIONS

1. In a large stock pot over medium heat add olive oil. Add carrots, peppers, onions and garlic. Cook, stirring until the onions are golden between 10-15 minutes.
2. Add green chili peppers, ancho chili pepper, cumin and cook for another 2 minutes. Stir in crushed tomatoes, beans, tomato paste, salt and pepper. Bring to a boil and reduce the heat to medium low.
3. Simmer uncovered while stirring occasionally for an hour. Taste and adjust the seasonings. If needed, add a small amount of water. Ladle into bowl and serve with toppings.
