Dark Skies Rally James River State Park May 1 thru May 4, 2025

Nestled in the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains, the park features rolling grasslands, quiet forests and beautiful views, as well as 3 miles of shoreline along the James River. The park's size is 1561 acres.

James River received the <u>International Dark Sky Park</u> designation in 2019 and is ideal for stargazing.

Lisa and I will be the Rally Masters for this event. We have reserved 12 sites in the Red Oak Campground. The Campground has sites with water and electricity and a full-service bathhouse with laundry facilities and a dump station



service bathhouse with laundry facilities and a dump station. The links below show a map of the campground and photos of the camp sites. Pets are permitted (Dogs must be on a leash)

We will work with the Park Ranger to arrange 1 or more interpretive sessions.

Depending on the weather, you can do a 2 hour or 6 hour float trip on the river. To lessen debris and its impact on wildlife, James River is a trash-in, trash-out facility.

The camping fee for 3 nights is \$113.00. We will advise you of the Rally Fee as we get closer to the Rally dates.

Chippokes State Park is in Surry County. It is named after the Chippokes Plantation which was established here in 1619. The original planter (Allen) named it Chippokes after a friendly Algonquin Indian chief. The property remains, even to this day, a working farm)

On-site activities include hiking, cycling, a farming museum, and two manor houses. The campground is modern, shady and spacious. All sites are paved and electric/water service. Check out the park at, https://www.dcr.virginia.gov/state-parks/chippokes

We will have a private tour of nearby Bacon's Castle (the oldest brick residence in the U.S.), a group dinner in Surry, and more to come.

South of the James attractions include charming Smithfield VA, Isle of Wight, and the Hampton Roads Winery (come for the wine, stay for the "goat tower"!).

We will be camping only 4.5 miles from the free ferry to historic Jamestown & Williamsburg (North of the James). A great opportunity for a cycling adventure!

We have reserved 12 campsites with water and 30/50-amp electric. A full-service bathhouse and dump station are on site. Sites will be assigned after we receive your Jotform registration and payment.

The campsite fee for three nights is \$135. The rally fee is \$20 per person.


