Some may be aware of the fundraiser Rose Garland organized at last year's International Rally in Sedalia for the remodel of a patient room at Bothwell Health Center in Sedalia. Here is a message from Rose:



Some of us returned to Sedalia on April 14 to witness the changes we made at the Bothwell Health Center. It truly touched my heart to see the \$10,000 transformation of one of the patient rooms. It was much more cheerful and bright.

We toured the infusion center where cancer patients receive treatment. We made a difference there with the remaining \$11,281.15 from outright donations, purchase of tee-shirts, and proceeds from that beautiful quilt raffle. Bothwell was able to purchase new computers to make the nurses job easier, new chairs to make the patients more comfortable, gas cards to help

rural patients receive treatment and Ensure to give patients nourishment to get through their treatments.

The rally was a massive success, welcoming approximately 2,625 people and 1,362 Airstream campers to the Missouri State fairgrounds. With extensive planning from key partners including the Convention and Visitors Bureau, the Sedalia chamber of commerce, and the city of Sedalia, the

event created a tremendous economic impact on local businesses. Notably, BTC Bank sponsored 2,625 Visa gift cards, with \$39,375 which attendees spent in Sedalia, further fueling the local economy.

Beyond boosting tourism, the Airstream rally left a lasting charitable impact on Sedalia:

1. a blood drive collected 164 units, saving 492 lives.

2. the WBCCI Foundation donated \$5,750 to the Katy trail.

3. the Common Cents for Kids donated \$8,000 to the Bothwell Foundation's children's programs.



4. the Bothwell Foundation received \$21,281.15 from tee-shirt sales and a quilt raffle.

The rally made a large economic impact. The tourism tax codes were up in October 2024 compared to October 2023. The rally helped increase revenue by over \$2.5 million in October. Gas stations showed an increase of \$158,000. Hotels reported an increase of \$113,000 in sales. Restaurants reported sales up \$138,000 in October.
