Park, a beautiful 614-acre park that sits at the
base of the Stissing Mountain range located
in northern Dutchess County in the Town of
Milan, New York. It has 11 miles of hiking
trails, one with a glorious Catskill view, fishing,
boating and one of the region's finest disc
golf courses.

The park has 10 shaded RV campsites sites in its Forest Acres Campground, each with 30 amp and water hookups, picnic table and fire ring, plus boondocking sites, if more spots are needed. The Dutchess County Parks and Recreation Department has blocked all 10 RV sites, so that we can have the whole park to ourselves!

The Leatherstocking Rally June 5-8 Glimmerglass State Park

1527 County Highway 31, Cooperstown, NY 13326

Glimmerglass State Park, located eight miles outside the village of Cooperstown, overlooks Otsego Lake, the "Glimmerglass" of James Fenimore Cooper's Leatherstocking Tales. The rolling, partially-wooded terrain is host to a wide variety of wildlife. An uphill trail through the forest affords a spectacular view of Otsego Lake; the Beaver Pond and Woodland trails are picturesque and of interest for the variety of wildflowers, shrubs, ferns and mosses.

The Hyde Hall Mansion, Covered Bridge, and a self-guided Beaver Pond Nature Trail are within park boundaries and open to visitors.

This is a stunning park!

Please check often for an available site and ask about overflow parking.
