

Despite the danger, they took the time to remove all of our club's memorabilia. With ash falling, daylight fading, and limited time, the good people at The Cove protected our club's irreplaceable history. I find this to be a remarkable story—one of the rare, true acts of selfless kindness.

There are entire books of photos and an abundance of memorabilia. I encourage everyone to take the time to visit the Founder's Lounge. And please, consider sending a message to The Cove to thank them for their quick thinking and courage during what must have been an incredibly stressful time.



The Davidson River runs through the campground. I am from Brevard and I'm super excited to show you my stomping grounds! This park has VERY high demand during summer months; therefore,

we must reserve our sites on February 8th, 2026, during the 6-month rolling release schedule. Please note that many sites do not have electricity, so be sure to select ones that do.

Our preferred loop will be Sycamore Loop (10 electrical sites). Whiteoak Loop (3), etc. Water and sewage hookups are not available at the sites; however, there are multiple freshwater spigot stations throughout the park and the clean bathhouses offer toilets & hot showers.



Food Babe's Low Sugar Cookies

Ingredients:

½ cup Coconut Oil, melted

1/4 cup Coconut Palm Sugar

1 Large Egg (1 Tbsp. Ground Flaxseed with 3 Tbsp. Water and let sit for 5 minutes)

1 Tbsp. Vanilla Extract

1 ¼ cup Almond Flour

1 ¼ cup Old Fashioned Oats

½ tsp. Baking Soda

½ tsp. Salt

2 tsp. Ground Cinnamon

½ cup Walnuts, chopped

½ cup Dried Currants or Raisins (optional mix in, feel free to get creative,

i.e. Raw Cocoa Nibs, Goji Berries, etc.)

Instructions:

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees F.
- 2. Place the coconut oil and sugar in a bowl and stir until well combined.
- 3. Add egg or flaxseed and vanilla extract and stir for another minute until smooth.
- 4. Add rest of ingredients and stir.
- 5. Place dough mixture in the refrigerator for 10 minutes.
- 6. Using an ice cream scooper or tablespoon, scoop out dough and press each cookie on a parchment paper-lined cookie sheet.
- 7. Bake for 15 minutes or until golden brown.
- 8. Cool at least 7 minutes and serve.
