Your vote really counts, and together, we can make a big difference.



## Reservation Booking Change—Indiana State Parks

Beginning April 30, campers will have until 11 p.m. ET on their day of arrival to reserve a site at <u>camp.IN.gov</u>. In the past, the cut-off for same-day reservations was 2 p.m. ET., requiring customers to hope for the best after that time if they wanted to drive to a state park and try their luck at getting a campsite for the night.

The growing desire from customers to know the campsite availability prior to packing up their family and camping gear to drive across the state, is the primary reason for extending the minimum booking window until 11 p.m. ET. Allowing reservations every evening until the time quiet hours begin, gives last-minute campers a chance to check availability and book their stay so they are guaranteed a site before they hit the road.

The reservation phone line is another booking option, but with limited hours. Call 1-866-622-6746, Monday-Friday, noon to 8 p.m. ET; or Saturday/Sunday, noon to 5.p.m. ET.

Take advantage of this opportunity to book a campsite until 11 p.m. ET, beginning April 30. We look forward to seeing you in the parks this year. Happy camping!




## Tiny Tabs, Big Impact: Airstreamers for RMHC

#### Rally Pricing: There will be two pricing options for camping at The Fitness Farm.


