White Bean Chicken Chili

Ingredients:

- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 1 onion, chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 (14.5 ounce) can chicken broth
- 1 (18.75 ounce) can tomatillos, drained and chopped
- 1 (16 ounce) can diced tomatoes
- 1 (7 ounce) can diced green chiles
- ½ teaspoon dried oregano
- ½ teaspoon ground coriander seed
- ¼ teaspoon ground cumin
- 1 pound diced, cooked chicken meat
- 1 (15 ounce) can white beans
- 2 ears fresh corn kernels cut from cob
- 1 pinch salt and black pepper to taste

Directions:

- 1. Gather ingredients.
- 2. Heat oil in a large pot, and cook onion and garlic until soft.
- 3. Stir in broth, then add in tomatillos, tomatoes, and chiles. Stir together and season with oregano, coriander, and cumin. Bring to a boil, then simmer for 10 minutes.
- 4. Add chicken, beans, and corn; simmer 5 minutes. Season with salt and pepper to taste.
- 5. Serve hot and enjoy!

Cook's Note

I do double down on chicken, spices and white beans - to each his own!

As I sit here drinking my morning latte watching the rain fall on the lush fields of the California Central Valley, I realize I like the journey of Airstreaming as much as the destinations.



That lead to buying a trailer and the only option for us was an Airstream. As we could not go on our planned honeymoon, we ordered a new Airstream and picked it up in Northern California after a four-month wait.
