SMORES DIP IN A CAST IRON SKILLET

2 Cups of chocolate chips

16 large marshmallows

Graham crackers for dipping

- 1. Preheat the oven to 450.
 - 2. In a cast iron skillet, add the chocolate chips. Snip the large marshmallows in half and top the chocolate chips with them. (You could also use a scoop of mini marshmallows alternatively.)
 - 3. Once the oven is up to temperature, add the skillet to the oven. Bake for 7-9 minutes, or until the marshmallows turn golden brown.
 - 4. Serve with graham crackers for scooping.





Air Safe Trailer Hitch

About 6 months ago Donna and I took our trailer to Vinnie's to repair a dent in the rear (self-inflicted). We have a 2022 Globetrotter with a front Queen bed and I asked Vinnie if we were starting to see some frontend separation as 2 rivets around the front compartment storage door had popped. He said fortunately the separation had not started but he recommended the use of the Air Safe hitch that would greatly alleviate the possible damage and repair expense that seems to be occurring on these 27' trailers.

After some discussion I was able to get purchasing approval (Donna) to install the hitch and Vinnie was actually the one that installed it. The hitch is definitely a beast and I have since left it attached to our F-250 as it is relatively heavy as well.

Having used it for 6 months we've noticed a much smoother ride and items inside the trailer aren't thrown around like they used to be. No cabinet or refrigerator doors opening and the bathroom cabinet mirror that had opened once and cracked stayed put, and no more popped rivets.

The hitch eliminated jerking, bouncing and chucking over bumps in the road. The Air Safe hitches feature a free-floating airbag system for superior shock absorption, without pivoting or hinged points, enhancing ride quality. The added length of the trailer hitch also allows for a better turning radius.

One user on Airstream addicts Facebook page made the following observation:

I took this picture after driving back from Grass Valley RV resort back to Vinnie's to drop off my Airstream. Proof the <u>Air Safe Hitch</u> works wonders. The L-shape lock pin stayed on the frame exactly where I left it when I left <u>Grass Valley RV Park</u>. My senior moment


The hitch cost was not cheap, \$1500 installed but we believe it will be worth it in the long run.








