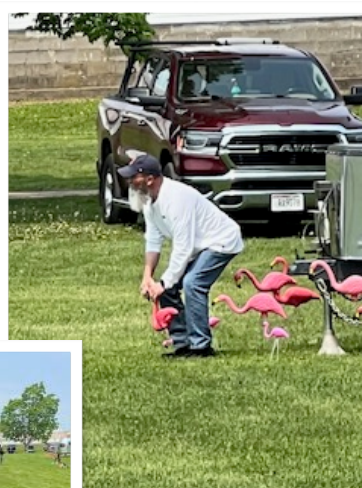

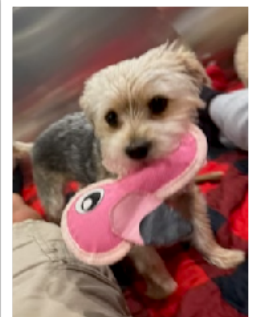

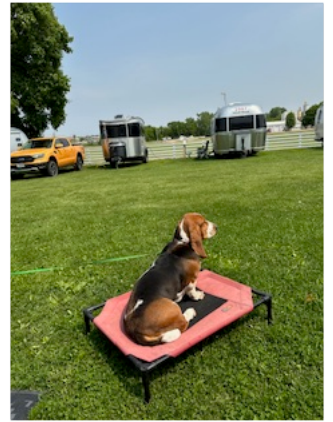
Dogs, many dogs making friends at this rally.
